JACKSON COUNTY. Boundaries — North by Douglas, east by the Cascade Mountains, south by the State of California, and west by Josephine. Area, 3,000 square miles. Rogue River Valley lies in Jackson County, and embraces lands of superior quality for agricultural purposes. A considerable portion is admirably adapted for grazing, and an abundance of timber for manufacturing purposes is found throughout the mountainous section. Extensive ledges of gold and silver exist, which afford employment to a large number of persons; and copper, iron and coal have been discovered, but have not as yet been developed to any extent. An excellent article of salt is now being manufactured in large quantities. County seat, Jacksonville.
