The population is small, and but little effort has been made as yet to develop the resources of the county. Mount Adams, one of the peaks of the Cascade Range, is within the limits of this county, the height of which is 9,570 feet. County seat, Rockland. Area of the county, 2,000 square miles. (No returns of County Officers received.)

LEWIS COUNTY. Boundaries—North by Thurston and Pierce, east by the Cascade Mountains, south by Skamania, Clarke and Cowlitz, and west by Chehalis. The land in this county is generally uneven, but fertile and productive. Value of assessable property, \$230,453. Area, estimated, 1,720 square miles. County seat, Claquato.
