

*RAILROADS.

- CENTRAL PACIFIC—Overland and accommodation trains for San José, Sacramento, Stockton, and Marysville—from Oakland Ferry Wharf; City Station, foot of Market Street.
- CENTRAL PACIFIC—Local trains from Oakland Ferry Wharf to East Oakland. Stations: Oakland Point, Center Street, Adeline Street, Market Street, Broadway, Oak Street, Seventh Avenue, and Thirteenth Avenue. To Alameda, same stations to Broadway, thence to Alameda.
- ALAMEDA, OAKLAND, AND PIEDMONT (Horse Cars)—From the corner of Broadway and Seventh to Alameda.
- BERKELEY BRANCH NORTHERN RAILWAY—Connects at Oakland Point Station with Oakland and Alameda trains. Stations: Shell Mound, San Pablo Avenue, Adeline Street, and Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley.
- BROADWAY AND PIEDMONT (Horse Cars)—From the corner of Seventh and Washington to Fourteenth Street, thence through Broadway and Webster Streets to Mountain View Cemetery.
- BROOKLYN AND FRUIT VALE (Horse Cars)—From foot of Thirteenth Avenue to Fruit Vale Avenue.
- EAST OAKLAND, FRUIT VALE, AND MILLS' SEMINARY (Horse Cars)—From foot of Thirteenth Avenue to East Fourteenth Street, thence to Fruit Vale and Mills' Seminary.
- OAKLAND (Horse Cars)—From foot of Broadway to Telegraph Avenue, thence to Berkeley, and from the corner of Broadway and Seventh to San Pablo Avenue, thence to a point opposite Oakland Trotting Park.
- OAKLAND, BROOKLYN, AND FRUIT VALE (Horse Cars)—From the corner of Broadway and Seventh to Twelfth Street, thence to the corner of East Twelfth and Thirteenth Avenue, East Oakland.

PROMINENT PLACES.

- Berkeley, four miles northeast of City Hall.
- Butchertown, three miles north of City Hall.
- Fruit Vale, four miles east of City Hall.
- Gibbon's Point, now Oakland Point.
- Lake Merritt, half a mile east of City Hall.
- Lake Park, two and a half miles northeast of City Hall.
- Lake Side, near northern shore of Lake Merritt, one mile and a half east of City Hall.
- Lynn, two miles and a quarter east of City Hall.
- Mountain View Cemetery, termination of Webster Street, two and a half miles from City Hall.
- Oakland Point, western portion of the city fronting the bay.
- Oakland Trotting Park, San Pablo Avenue, near the terminus of the San Pablo Avenue Railroad.
- Piedmont Springs, three miles northeast of City Hall.
- San Antonio Creek, between Oakland and Alameda, emptying into the bay.
- Sessionsville, two miles and a half east of City Hall.
- Temescal, two miles north of the City Hall.
- West Berkeley, four miles north of City Hall.

*A street railroad is now in the course of construction, which will extend from the intersection of Broadway and Fourteenth Street to West Oakland. A branch of this road will extend from the main track to the foot of Market.
