Taken altogether, it is hoped that the Directory will be found valuable as a reference, useful as a guide, and interesting as a social *souvenir*. There is no particular apology to offer for its existence; no very superior quality claimed for its contents; no consolation that we can think of to offer the displeased; no object to achieve, unless it be a poor and humble place
