

THE STANDARD THEATRE.

THE Standard is on the north side of Bush street between Kearny and Montgomery. Its present lessee is M. H. Kennedy, who has had it handsomely refitted and refurnished. The box-office and manager's private office are on the left of the vestibule, which leads directly from the street to the dress-circle. The auditorium is furnished with mirrors, and the benches are neatly upholstered. The parquette and dress-circle seat 500 persons. There are four proscenium boxes, accommodating four persons each. M. H. Kennedy is lessee and manager; C. S. Walton, treasurer; Philip H. Kirby, business manager; and M. Straus, scenic artist.
