This Manufactory, which is located at Potrero, was established in 1856, by Messrs. Flint, Peabody & Co., and Messrs Tubbs & Co., and has been successfully conducted ever since. The buildings are upon the most extensive scale—that used as the rope-walk being one thousand feet in length, the department devoted to the spinning of the yarn being one hundred feet long by forty feet in width. The material used is Manilla hemp—regular shipments being made for this purpose. This Manufactory gives constant employment to fifty hands, who turn out 2,000,000 pounds of cordage during the year—about 6,000 pounds of the raw material being consumed each day in the manufacture.
