Alviso. Yachting, fishing, rowing, duck hunting, and warm salt water bathing. Six miles from San Jose, on San Francisco Bay. Reached by train from the Alameda depot, or drive.

Saline City (Drawbridge). Beyond Alviso. Favorite place for clubs. Has fifty-three club houses. Good fishing, rowing, bathing, hunting.

Edenvale (and South). Place of beautiful homes and fine orchards. A day's carriage ride south from San Jose; is well worth while.

Berryessa Drive. A short journey by team for those who would see model fruit section. Electric road now in course of construction to this point.

The Big Trees. A twenty-seven-mile side trip from San Jose to the great redwoods of Santa Cruz Mountains. May be visited en route from south to San Jose via Santa Cruz.

Located in the center of the city is St. James Park, where may be found growing more varieties of trees than found in any other park of any city in the world. It is well kept and presents a charming feature. When President McKinley made his trip through California and to San Jose he was presented in the St. James Park with an enormous bouquet of flowers and when news of his death was flashed to San Jose the citizens immediately subscribed for the erection of a beautiful monument and placed it upon the very spot where he delivered his address to the people of San Jose while in this city. The monument rests in the St. James Park, an emblem of devotion by the citizens to a martyred President.

In the City of San Jose we have seven banks and the clearing-house shows an average of \$2,500,000 in clearings per month, while the deposits for a year average \$50,000,000. The climate is the best all-year-round in the state and will average from 50 degrees in winter to 70 degrees in summer. The city has an elevation of 84 feet above sea level and is on the floor of the valley with good drainage into San Francisco Bay, which is located 8 miles north of the city. The educational advantages are unsurpassed. We have the kindergarten, grammar schools, high school, State Normal, College of Notre Dame, King's Conservatory of Music, San Jose Business College, Pacific Coast Business College, Modern School of Business, and within the county and linked by electric roads is the famous Stanford University, the most richly endowed in the world, Santa Clara College, where the original Santa Clara Mission
