Has efficient school facilities; bank, cannery, winery and fruit drying establishments. Streets well cared for, lighted by electricity and gas. Good sewer system. The stone and concrete bridge across Los Gatos Creek the largest structure of its kind in California. Good hotels. All the churches and fraternal societies well represented. Electric road to San Jose, half-hour service. Elevation at railroad depot 412 feet.
