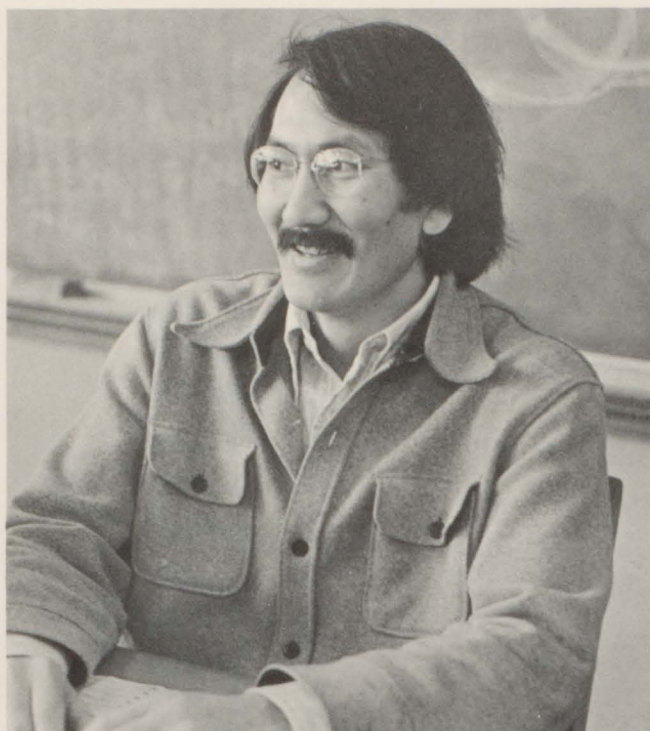
Mr. Castle's interest in students was reflected by their admiration and trust; several times he was selected by the students as the best or most popular teacher.

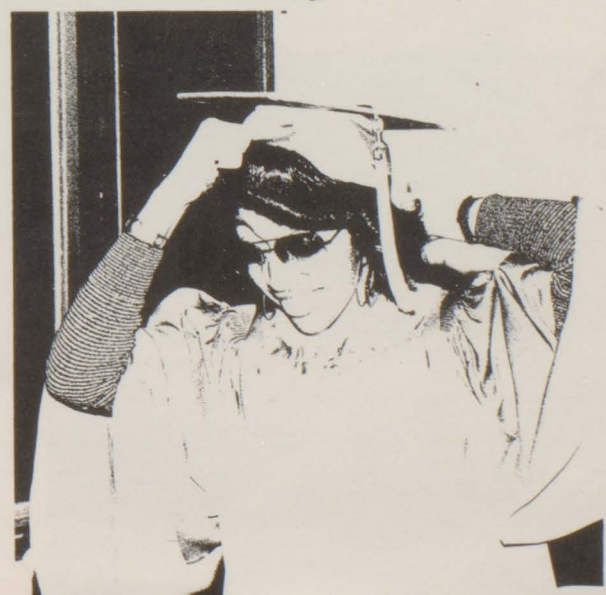
Mr. Richard Fukuwa, one of the most popular teachers at George Washington died suddenly of cancer on May 8, 1974.

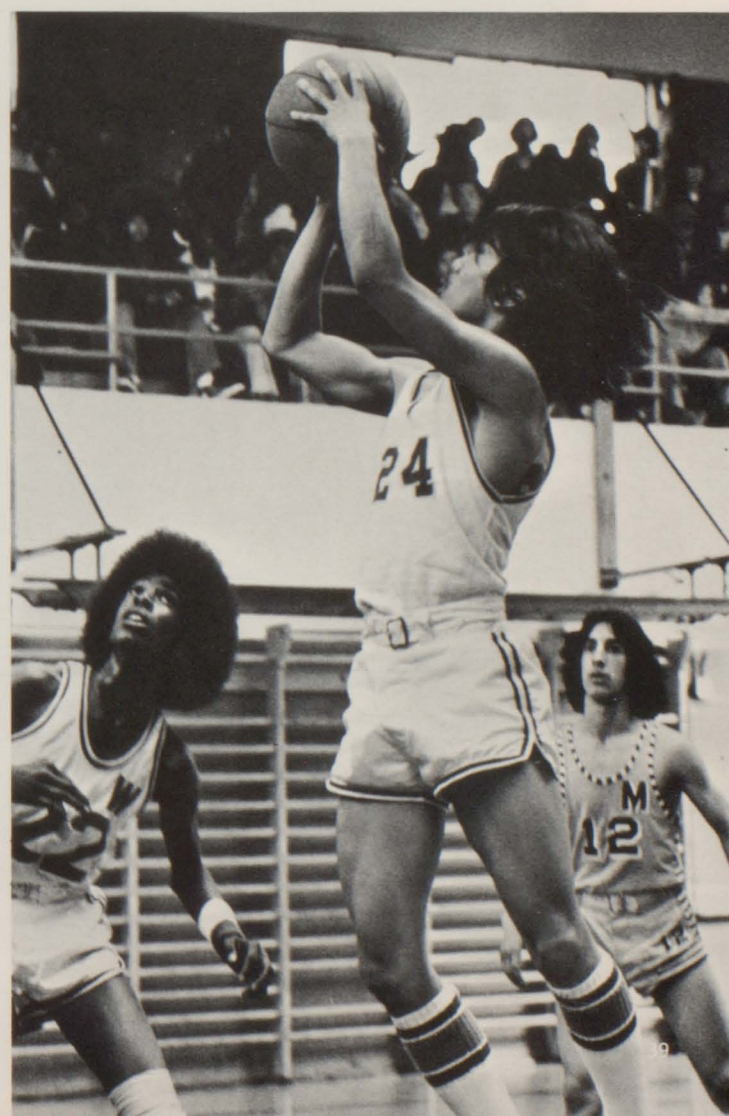
