

relations of Britain and Russia should be through understanding of each other's ways," says Orekhov, who spent the first years of his life in Russia and then emigrated to Germany. 


It is our intention that each and every student at Livermore High School will receive not only a sound education, but also one best suited to his or her abilities.

This year the Senior Class presented the zany comedy, "You Can't Take It With You," a story of the mad and merry antics of the Sycamore family.



As the players have gained one more year's experience, we are sure our Cowboy team will be more successful next year.




