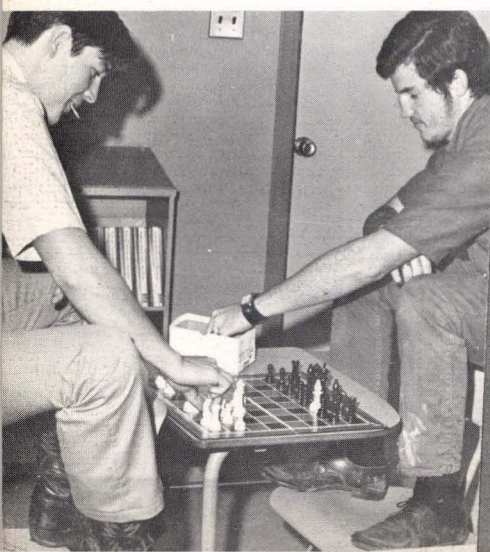


## *Chess Club*

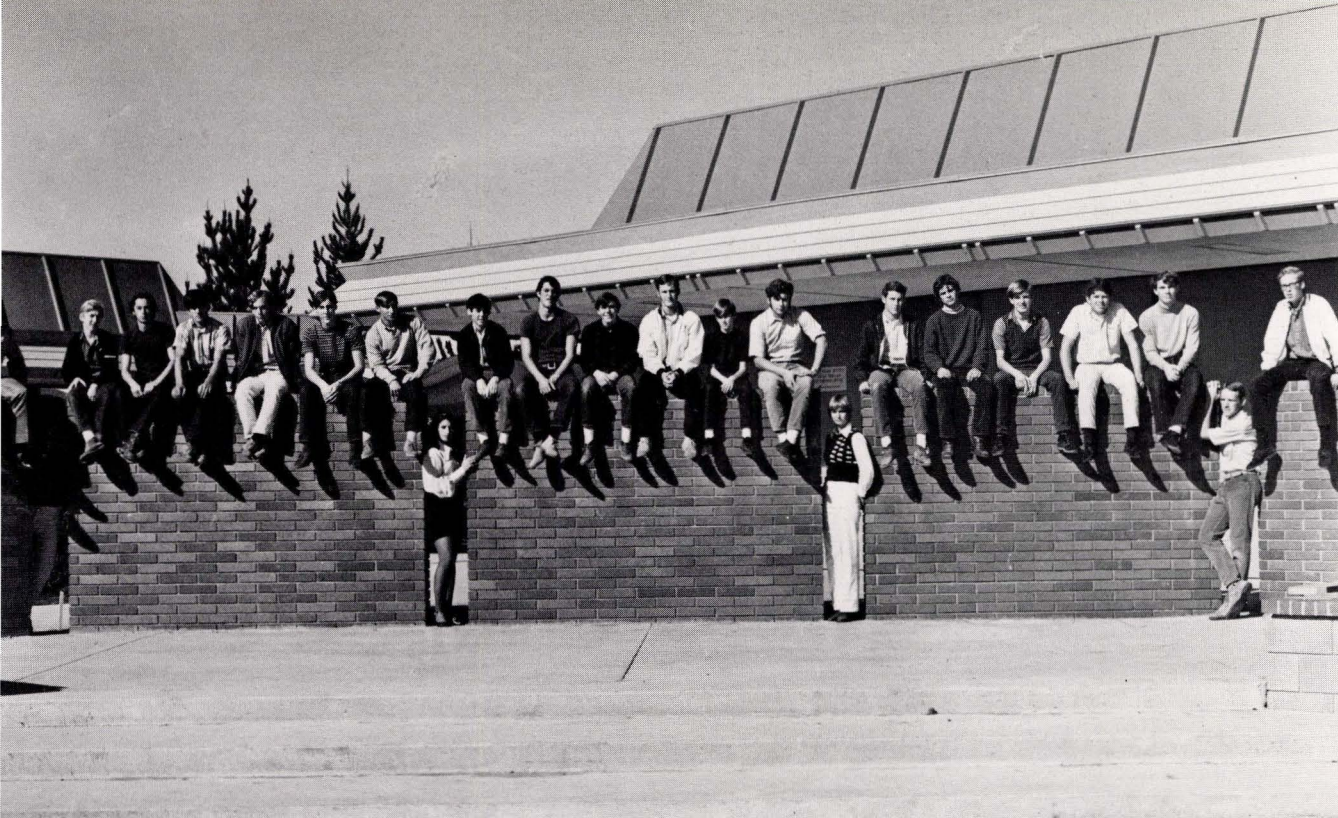

## *Marine Biology Club*

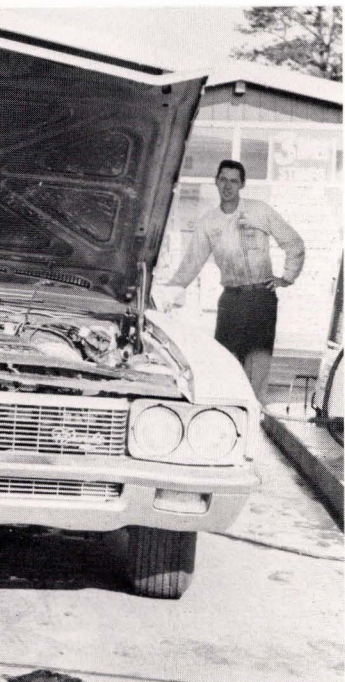
