TERMS OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS.

BAKER COUNTY.....	Fourth Monday in May, and first Monday in November.
BENTON COUNTY.....	Second Monday in April, and November.
CLACKAMAS COUNTY.....	Third Monday in March, and fourth Monday in October.
CLATSOP COUNTY.....	Fourth Tuesday in April, and first Tuesday in October.
COLUMBIA COUNTY.....	Third Tuesday in April.
COOS COUNTY.....	Fourth Monday in May.
CURRY COUNTY.....	First Monday in June.
DOUGLAS COUNTY.....	Second Monday in May and October.
GRANT COUNTY.....	Second Monday in June, and third Monday in October.
JACKSON COUNTY.....	Second Monday in February, June, and November.
JOSEPHINE COUNTY.....	Second Monday in April, and fourth Monday in October.
LANE COUNTY.....	Third Monday in April, and fourth Monday in October.

*The Judicial power of the State is vested in a Supreme Court and five Circuit Courts. The Supreme Court consists of five Justices, chosen in districts, by the electors thereof who are also Judges of the Circuit Court in their respective districts. Their term of office is six years. There is one Prosecuting Attorney in each Judicial District, elected by the people for two years. For organization and terms of the United States Courts, see pages 30-32.
