MANUFACTURES.

The attention of the early inhabitants of this portion of the Pacific, having been for years after the first settlement of the State almost entirely devoted to agricultural pursuits and the raising of stock, for which the greater portion of its area is admirably adapted, but little was done for a series of years towards the diversion of its immense water power and other resources to manufacturing purposes. No other portion of the world possesses superior advantages for the manufacture of the great staples which mainly make up the commerce of the world. This department is yet in its infancy here, and we are only able to give the following brief synopsis of its operations.

GRIST MILLS—FLOUR.

The number of Grist Mills in the State is sixty-three, of which fifty-five are propelled by water, with an aggregate run of stone of one hundred. Several of these mills are of the most extensive character, with a capacity of from two to three hundred barrels per day.
