

AGRICULTURAL.

The agricultural and grazing facilities of this Territory are said to be unsurpassed. The soil is capable of growing the finest wheat, barley, etc., while the hill-sides are covered with the most nutritious grasses in the world. The valleys of Gallatin, Deer Lodge, and Jefferson have produced fine crops of the cereals; and wherever they have been planted, rich returns have rewarded the husbandman. "Along the valleys of both the Hell Gate and Bitter Root there is a great abundance of excellent timber—pine, hemlock, tamarack, or larch, predominating. The numerous mountain rivulets tributary to the Bitter Root which run through the valley afford excellent and abundant mill seats. The valley and mountain slopes are well timbered with an excellent growth of pine, which is equal in every respect to the well known and noted pine of Oregon."

GRIST MILLS, FLOUR.
