DOUGLAS COUNTY. Boundaries—North by Lane, east by the Cascade Mountains, south by Jackson and Josephine, and west by Coos and the Pacific Ocean. By Act of Legislature, Umpqua County is now consolidated with Douglas, which gives it the largest area (over 5000 square miles) of any county west of the Cascades. The surface is mountainous. Umpqua Valley lies wholly in this county, and is the largest in southern Oregon, and second only in importance to the Willamette. "It is most bountifully watered by the Umpqua River and its numerous branches and affluents, and it possesses a soil so varied and fertile that every thing may be grown that can be raised in any of the Northwestern States." The unoccupied public lands afford admirable grazing facilities for large herds of stock. Acres of arable land estimated at 233,000. Real and personal property, 1864, \$1,410,259. County seat, Roseburg.
