HUMBOLDT COUNTY. Boundaries—North by State of Oregon, east by Lander, south by Churchill, and west by Washoe and Roop. It is estimated that there are in this county 150,000 acres of land suitable for agricultural purposes, and 640,000 acres adapted to the raising of stock. Along the banks of the Humboldt River are found thousands of acres of rich arable and grazing land. The silver mines of Humboldt County have long been known to be among the richest in the State, the ledges being large and well defined. Considerable excitement has been occasioned by the recent discovery of the "Black Rock" Mines, which are represented to be exceedingly rich in mineral wealth. Several mills are in course of erection in this district. Gold, lead, copper, sulphur, salt, lime, etc., also exist. The great Humboldt Canal now being built, will, when completed, be of vast benefit to this section, furnishing unlimited water power for mill and manufacturing, and also for purposes of irrigation.
