In September, 1866, there were eight quartz mills, with an aggregate of 175 stamps, crushing ore from the "Comstock Lode," in Storey County. County seat, Carson City.

The newly discovered mining district of Black Rock, in Humboldt County, is causing the valleys in the southern seetion to be settled, and another year may work many changes. At present, however, but little attention has been paid to developing its resources, although wherever attempts have been made to cultivate the soil, they have proved highly encouraging and remunerative. In the neighborhood of Pyramid Lake there are fine agricultural and meadow lands, which form part of the "Indian Reservation."
