This city, the Metropolis of the State, is situated on the eastern slope of Mt Davidson, and is well built, containing many fine brick stores and public buildings. The population is variously estimated at from 8,000 to 10,000. The city proper occupies an area of four square miles, and extends from the northern line of Gold Hill, two miles north beyond Seven-mile Cañon. Its annual aggregate business forms an important item in the trade of the Pacific coast, and the energy and enterprise displayed in its prosecution is worthy of commendation.
