WASHOE COUNTY. Boundaries—North by Roop, east by Humboldt and Storey, south by Storey and Ormsby, and west by the State of California. This county has many fine natural lakes and valleys, and thousands of acres of the finest arable, grazing and timber land in the State. The number of acres under cultivation in 1864 was 10,450. Mining operations have not, as yet, been carried on to any considerable extent, though many rich localities have been prospected. Superior copper ore is obtained from Peavine District, about 25 miles north of Washoe City.
