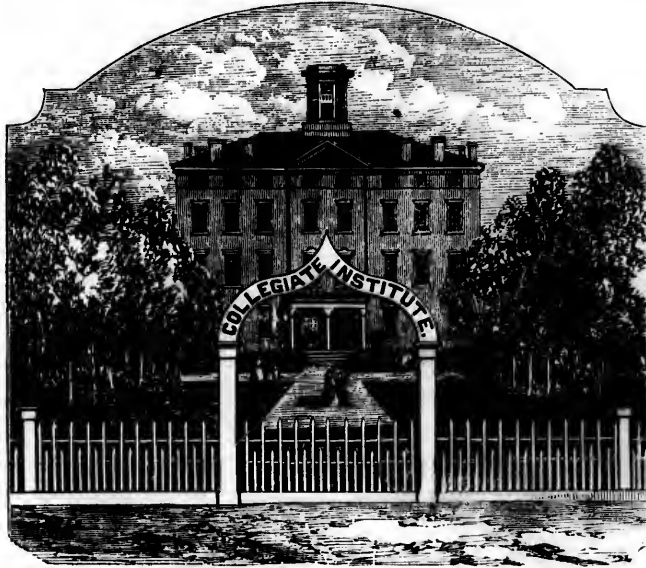




NAPA COLLEGIATE INSTITUTE

This Institution is located in Napa City, which, in point of climate and natural scenery, is unsurpassed in the State. It is easy of access, there being a daily boat from San Francisco, and daily stages from Sacramento and Benicia. It is on the line of travel to the White Sulphur Springs, Calistoga Springs and the Geysers. The building is constructed with a special view to a mixed school. The best teaching talent of the State will be secured at whatever expense. Thoroughness in scholarship will ever be prominent before the instructors. There are two fine gymnasiums and ample play grounds connected with the Institute. The teachers reside in the building, and have a constant oversight of the students who are boarders, but cannot be responsible for those who board in the town or country. CALENDAR.
