been proposed to extend the boundaries of the larger city. On the beach, five miles north of the city, a new city to be called Berkeley, is to be laid out. The site chosen for it, is exactly opposite the Golden Gate. As the train glides slowly out of the city, one receives the impression that everything is very beautiful, and that all the people must be wealthy. This impression is nearly correct, for many of the merchant princes of San Francisco reside here, who have surrounded themselves with great luxury and beauty.
