TO INGLESIDE—Daily trains will leave San Francisco for Ingleside from Third and Townsend Streets on and after Saturday, November 15th, at 12:45 and 1:15 P. M. Returning, leave Ingleside after the races. Single fare, 20 cents; round trip, 30 cents.
 Note—Any line transferring to Mission, Howard, Bryant or San Mateo lines, also passengers presenting transfers to Polk and Larkin, 3rd and Kearny or Fillmore and Sixteenth reissue to Kearny and Mission Streets line direct.

Ferry boats leave San Francisco at 12 M., and 12:30, 1:00, 1:30, 2:00, 2:30 and 3:00 P. M., connecting with trains stopping at the entrance to the track. Last two cars on trains reserved for ladies and their escorts; no smoking. Buy your ferry tickets to Shell Mound. Returning: trains leave the track at 4:15 and 4:45 P. M., and immediately after the last race.
