IN EACH CLASS NOTHING HAS BEEN LEFT UNDONE THAT WILL TEND TO THE SAFETY AND COMPORT OF TRAVELERS. THE SHIPS ARE BUILT TO COMPLY WITH NAVY REGULATIONS AND CAN BE TURNED INTO AUXILIARY CRUISERS INSIDE OF 36 HOURS. THE UPPER DECK CABINS ARE ALL LARGE SIZE, LIGHTED AND VENTILATED BY WINDOWS OPENING ON THE UPPER DECK CHAIRS AND COMPORT GIVE THE APPEARANCE OF ROOMS IN A MODERN HOTEL RATHER THAN ON AN OCEAN LINER. THE ENTRANCE TO THE CABINS IS FROM THE CENTRAL HALL INSTEAD OF FROM THE DECK. THE SOCIAL HALL, DINING ROOM, BATH ROOMS, TOILETS, ETC., ARE ALL REACHED UNDER COVER. THE SECOND CABINS ARE LOCATED WELL FORWARD FROM THE STEIN, AND WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ONE OR TWO ROOMS, ARE ALL OUTSIDE. THEY ARE LARGE AND EACH CONTAINS FOUR BERTHS. THIRD CLASS ACCOMMODATIONS HAVE ALSO RECEIVED ATTENTION, DINING ROOM BEIND PROVIDED FOR THIS CLASS, SHOWER BATHS, AND EVERYTHING THAT GOES TO MAKE THE TRIP COMFORTABLE. ALL NECESSARIES FOR THIS CLASS OF PASSAGE ARE PROVIDED BY THE COMPANY.
