

Suisun.

This town, situated about one mile south of Fairfield and separated from it by a narrow strip of swamp land, is built upon an elevation in the tule lands and is at the head of a navigable arm of Suisun Bay which is capable of carrying vessels of one hundred tons burden. Almost the entire grain crop and a large portion of the other productions of this part of the county are shipped by this route. It is also a station on the California Pacific Railroad, has post, express and telegraph offices and a population of 700.
