District—Bounded North by the Bay, East by Montgomery,
South by Jackson, and West by Larkin Street. Signal,
two strokes of the bell. Third District—Bounded North by
Jackson, East by Bay, South by Sacramento, and West by
Montgomery Street. Signal, three strokes of bell. Fourth
District—Bounded North by Jackson, East by Montgomery,
West by Larkin, and South by Clay Street. Signal, four
strokes of bell. Fifth District—Bounded North by Sacra-
mento, East by Bay, South by Market, and West by Mont-
gomery Street. Signal, five strokes of bell. Sixth Dis-
trict—Bounded North by Clay, East by Montgomery, South
by Bush, and West by Larkin Street. Signal, six strokes of
bell. Seventh District—Bounded North by Market, South
by Fourth Street, East and West by Bay and Bincon
Point. Signal, seven strokes of bell. Eighth District—
Bounded North by Bush, and extending to Mission Dolores.
Signal, eight strokes of bell.
