## City Improvements.

In accordance with the design marked out when the publication of our Directory was first commenced, we have called into requisition every possible means of giving a correct idea of the improvements made in our rapidly-growing city during the past year. As it would be impossible to enumerate all the improvements made or to enter into detailed enumeration, the scope and limits of our work will only permit us to give a general outline of the whole. The growth and extension of our city during the past twelve months has been unexampled in its own remarkable history, and probably unequaled by that of any other city of the same population in the world during the same time. The developments of the rich mineral resources of Nevada Territory, and the rich mining regions north and south of us, bringing to these shores an influx of population hitherto unparalleled, fully accounts for the ready and rapid march of improvements in our city.
