The Kleinhans retired in 1860, and Newton Booth again entered the firm. L. A. Booth and T. L. Barker retired from the firm in 1862, and J. T. Glover became a member. This firm stlll continues, and that, too, with all the surroundings of prosperity. Its business relations extend not only through the northern and southern counties of the State, but also through the entire State of Nevada.]
