. SEC. 14. The Superintendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squares may require, at h option, by notice in writing, to be delivered to them personally or left on the premises, t owners, tenants, or occupants of lots, or portions of lots, liable to be assessed for work dor under the provisions of this Act, to improve forthwith any of the work mentioned in section three of this Act, in front of the property of which he is the owner, tenant, or occupant, to t center of the street, or otherwise, as the case may require, or to remove all filth, sand, earth, dirt from the street in front of his premises, and by a like notice to be served personally up the President or any officer of a railroad corporation or company, or to be left at the office said corporation or company, to require such corporation or company to improve forthwith an work mentioned in this Act, which said corporation or company are required by law to do an perform; said notice to specify what improvement is required or work is to be done. After t expiration of five days the said Superintendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squares she be deemed to have acquired jurisdiction to contract for the doing of the work or making t improvements, or the removing of the filth, sand, earth, or dirt required by said notice. aforesaid, and diligently and without interruption prosecuted to completion, the said Supertendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squares may enter into a contract with any suital person to make said improvement or to do said cleaning, at the expense of the owner, tenan or occupant, or railroad corporation or company, as the case may be, at a reasonable price, be determined by said Superintendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squares; and su owner, tenant, or occupant, or railroad corporation or company, shall be liable to pay the sam After the certificate referred to in section tifteen shall have been recorded in the office of [t Superintendent of] Public Streets, Highways, and Squares, the sum contracted to be paid she be a lien, the same as provided in section ten of this Act, and also a lien upon the franchi and property of said corporation or company, and may be enforced in the same manner as oth assessments.

SEC. 15. If the expense of such improvements or removing such sand, earth, dirt, or filt after the completion thereof, be not paid to the contractor so employed, or his agent or assign on demand, the said contractor or his assigns shall have the right to sue the owner, tenant, occupant, or railroad corporation or company, under the provisions of this Act, for the amou contracted to be paid, and the certificate of the Superintendent of Public Streets, Highway and Squares that the work has been properly done, and that the charges for the same are re sonable and just, shall be prima facie evidence of the amount claimed for said work, and of t right of the contractor to recover the same in such action.

In addition and as cumulative to the remedies above given, the Board of Supe SEC. 16. visors shall have power, by ordinance, to prescribe the penalties that shall be incurred by a owner, tenant, occupant, or railroad corporation or company neglecting or refusing to ma Act, which fines and penalties shall be recovered for the use of the City and County of S Francisco, by prosecution, in the name of the People of the State of California, in the Pol Judge's Court, of the City and County of San Francisco, which shall have jurisdiction in such eases. All fines collected hereunder shall be paid into the treasury of the City and Count of Court of the City and County of San Francisco, which shall have jurisdiction in such eases. of San Francisco to the credit of the Street Department Fund, at least once in each week.

SEC. 17. The person owning the fee, or the person in possession of lands, lots, or portions lots or buildings, under claim of ownership, or exercising acts of ownership over the same, himself, or as the administrator or guardian of the owner, or the person in whom on the d the action commenced appears the legal title to the lands by deeds, recorded in the Recorde office in the City and County of San Francisco, shall be regarded, treated, and deemed to be owner (for the purpose of this law), according to the intent and meaning of that word as us

in this Act; and in case of property leased, possession by a tenant or lessee holding and or pying under an owner shall be deemed to be possession by such owner. SEC. 18. The records kept by the Superintendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squar in conformity with the provisions of this Act, and signed by him, shall have the same force a effect as other public records; and such records or copies thereof, duly certified by said Super tendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squares may be used in evidence with the same fo and effect as the original assessments, diagrams, and warrants; the said records shall, during office hours, be open to the inspection of any citizen wishing to examine them, free of char

Notices in writing, which are required to be given by the Superintendent of P SEC. 19. ic Streets, Highways, and Squares, under the provisions of this Act, may be served by a Police Officer, and the fact of such service shall be verified by the oath of the person making taken before the Superintendent (who is hereby authorized to administer oaths), Police Jud or any Judge or Justice of the Peace, or such notices, whether verbal or written, may be de ered by the Superintendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squares himself, or any of Deputies. The Superintendent of Public Streets, Highways, and Squares shall keep a rec of the fact of giving such notices and proof of service. SEC. 20.
