## NOTICE TO KEYHOLDERS.

Keys to be used only in case of actual necessity. If this request is not complied with, the Key will be taken from the holder.  
 Upon the discovery or positive information of a fire near your Signal Box, pull down the hook once and let go; then wait a few moments, and if you hear no alarm from the large Bells or Whistles, pull down again; if you still hear no alarm, go to the next nearest box and give the alarm from that. If no light shows up, wait at the box and direct the men to fire. Never signal for a fire seen at a distance. Be sure your box is locked before leaving it.  
**Do not give an Alarm for a Burning Chimney.** Give an alarm for no cause whatever, except an actual fire. Second, Third and General Alarms will be turned in only by order of the Chief Engineer or his Assistants.
