History of the Marine's Club

HERE IN THE VERY HEART OF SAN FRANCISCO'S business section stands the only memorial of its kind in the world. The Marines' Memorial Club, "Crossroads of the Corps," is a million dollar living tribute to the Leathernecks who gave everything that those of us who remain may have something. Here any Marine from any war, regardless of rank or creed may enjoy the luxury of a swank downtown social club with its dining rooms, lounges, weekly dances, swimming pool, library, 115 hotel rooms and the Skyroom overlooking San Francisco Bay; he may enjoy all facilities, entertain guests, and there are no membership fees, dues or assessments.

Unusual, too, is the fact that every dime towards the purchase of this 12-story building and its furnishings came from the Marines themselves. Individually every Marine who saw service in World War II contributed his part through his purchases at his Marine Post Exchange.

THIS CLUB IS FOR ALL MARINES, officers and enlisted; former (honorably discharged) Marines; and the families and friends of Marines and former Marines. Associate memberships are available for hospital corpsmen and for veterans of other services who have served with Marines in time of war.
