Directory of the Quad.—The rooms in the quadrangle are numbered consecutively, beginning at the left of the main entrance, ten numbers being allotted to each building. Numbers 120 to 160 are in the Engineering buildings, south of the quadrangle. The Psychological laboratory is in the brick building near Escondite Cottage. The office of the President is room 112; Registrar, room 110; the Library is room 2.

Dormitories.—The University dormitories are Encina, for the men, and Roble, for the women. The rooms contain two single beds, with pillows and mattresses, a wardrobe, dresser, study table, chairs, electric lights, and water, and are heated by steam. The cost is \$25 per month for board and room.
