

THE CHESS CLUB is composed of several of the expert players of the University. It aims to foster an interest in the game, meeting for practice and holding an occasional tournament.

FRATERNITIES.—The Greek world is represented by Zeta Psi, Phi Delta Theta, Phi Kappa Psi, Sigma Rho Eta (local), Sigma Nu, Sigma Chi, Sigma Alpha Epsilon, Delta Tau Delta, Beta Theta Pi, Chi Psi, Kappa Alpha, Delta Upsilon, the legal fraternity of Phi Delta Phi, Theta Nu Epsilon, Sigma Sigma (local), and Phi Upsilon. Several other fraternities are represented but not organized. They are Delta Kappa Epsilon, Alpha Delta Phi, Phi Gamma Delta, and Alpha Tau Omega.

SORORITIES.—Kappa Alpha Theta, Kappa Kappa Gamma, Pi Beta Phi, Delta Gamma, and Epsilon Chi (local) have chapters. Alpha Phi and Gamma Phi Beta are represented.

THE CHORAL SOCIETY.—This society, including in its membership most of the singers in the University, has been conducted with much success during the past year. It is under very able leadership and has become a real source of musical education and culture. It meets weekly for practice, and occasional recitals are given. Membership is open to all students.

**Publications.**—Two papers are published at the University under the direction of the Associated Students. *The Sequoia* is a literary weekly, with a subscription price of \$2 yearly. *The Daily Palo Alto* is the newspaper and the official medium for notices. Its subscription price is \$3 yearly. No student should be without at least one of these papers. *The Stanford Quad* is the annual published by the Junior class. It is an artistic volume, giving much information regarding the character and *personnel* of University organizations, and illustrative of life on and about the campus through pictures, literature, and humorous pleasantries.

**Summer School.**—Courses in the Summer School are open to regularly matriculated students of the University, to teachers, and to others qualified to undertake the work. A
