Schools.—Palo Alto is well provided with schools. Graduates of the High School, Manzanita Hall, and Castilleja Hall are admitted to Stanford without examination, with the exception of English composition, which Stanford requires of all students. Besides these Palo Alto has a fine public school and a kindergarten.
