

## PALO ALTO DIRECTORY.

Explanatory.—Owing to the absence of any system of numbering the houses of Palo Alto, they are designated by the number of the block in which they are situated, and by their number in the block; reference being had to the map in the back of this Directory. The counting on the avenues is from the railroad toward the bay; on the streets, from the creek toward San Jose. On streets running through blocks, right and left are indicated by R and L respectively: e. g., Abbott, Mrs S H, Emerson 10, 1, is Emerson street, block 10, 1st house.
