

DIRECTORY OF PALO ALTO STREETS AND HOUSES BY NUMBERS

In emergencies this house list will be found specially useful. First look in the telephone book for the person wanted. If he cannot be reached directly that way and the occasion demands quick action look him up in the alphabetical list of names in the city directory. Then turn to this list of houses and find out who lives next door or near at hand. Then consult the telephone book, call up the neighbor and have a message sent to the person wanted. This method will save a great deal of time, but should be followed only when the need is urgent.

Streets in Palo Alto parallel the railroad tracks from north west to southeast. Avenues run at right angles to the streets from southwest to northeast. This arrangement places all residences in such positions that the sun shines into them at some time during the day. Streets and avenues follow:
