

PALO ALTO

The system of house numbering in use in Palo Alto was devised and arranged by H. W. Simkins while town clerk. It takes the Palo Alto tree for its base and meridian and each full block is a unit of 100. The numbers from 1 to 99 are discarded, to be used later when the avenues may be cut through to the county road. Two numbers are allowed for each 25 feet on each side of the street, the even numbers on the right and the odd numbers on the left side of the street. The half numbers are disregarded, except that fifty numbers are given to one side and fifty to the other in that block. Every row of blocks in either direction would have the same index numbers, as 500, 700 or 1200 block, and the index number would tell its distance in blocks from the base line.
