POPULATION OF THE EARTH.

The following table, giving the population of the earth, is from a report just issued by the United States Bureau of Statistics. The figures are borrowed chiefly from the work of Drs. Behm and Wagner, issued this year at Gotha, and are founded on the most recent authorities.
