The route of approach is easy and possible from any direction. By the Northern Pacific Railroad from San Francisco to Cloverdale, thence eighteen miles by Stage. From Calistoga by Stage, via Kelseyville. There is also a good road from Clear Lake, as well as good approaches from any of the other Springs. Fishing and Hunting can be indulged in to an unlimited extent.
