To facilitate sending telegrams, cablegrams, or radiograms, please call or dial telegraph

companies as listed in this directory. Charges for telegraph messages of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company at all exchanges and for telegraph messages of the Postal Telegraph-Cable Company and Western Union Telegraph Company at certain exchanges, placed by telephone, will be billed by the Telephone Company on its bill for service, or if sent from a coin telephone, the charges will be collected at the time the message is sent.

ATTACHMENTS TO TELEPHONES
