

LOCAL CALLS

FROM COIN TELEPHONES—You can dial all numbers with prefixes shown on the card at the telephone.

FROM ALL OTHER DIAL TELEPHONES—You

can dial local calls to any other telephone in the Sacramento exchange and to other nearby telephones as shown below.

PARTY LINE CALLS

When calling a local number, if you hear a high pitched tone it means the number you are calling is on your party line. Dial Repair Service to find out how to complete the call.

If you always hear a busy signal when calling a certain local number it may be that the number is on your party line. To find out if it is and how to complete your call dial Repair Service.

BUSINESS with the COMPANY

HELPFUL INFORMATION



Automatic ANSWERING SET

Certain telephones are equipped with an automatic device, known as an Automatic Answering Set, which answers the telephone mechanically when no person is available to answer and then makes a recorded announcement.

If your call is answered by an Automatic Answering Set, listen carefully for the announcement which will be self-explanatory.

Some of these sets will also receive and record a message from the caller.

When You Hear A "BEEP" TONE

If you hear a short high "beep" tone every 15 seconds or so, it means that the person with whom you are talking is recording your conversation. This signal is produced by recorder-connector equipment furnished by the Telephone Company. Use of a recorder on the telephone line without this equipment is prohibited by the Company's tariffs.

For faster service this attractive Blue Book of Telephone Numbers provides a handy place for keeping your personal list of local and out-of-town numbers.


