ZONE RATES

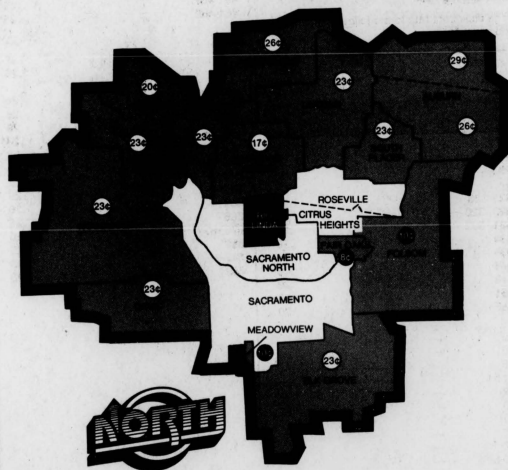
The amounts in the black circles indicate the one minute, zones 2 & 3 rates, for station calls you dial direct from residence or business phones.

Rio Linda local, nearby calling area, and rates

A21

Nearby rates (where no zone appears) are one minute rates from residence or business phones.

Zone calling and nearby rates are 30% lower weekdays from 5 P.M. to 11 P.M. and 60% lower from 11 P.M. to 8 A.M. and on Saturdays, Sundays and certain Holidays.

Higher rates apply to station calls dialed by the Operator, collect calls, person calls, calls billed to a Calling Card or to another number, and calls for time or charges. Minimum rates are \$.57 for station calls and \$3.17 for person calls.

Ask Operator for rates from Public (Coin) Telephones.

Listed below are one minute station rates when you dial direct from residence or business phones without Operator assistance, and excludes tax.
