VOICE RECORDING SIGNAL

If you are talking on the telephone and you hear a short high "beep" tone every 15 seconds or so, it is a voice-recording signal. This means the person you are talking to is recording your conversation. It

is against the law to use a recorder without this signal.

HOW TO CALL SOMEONE ON YOUR PARTY LINE

Dial Operator, give her the number, tell her it is on your line and she will help you make the call. To find out whether a neighbor's telephone is on your line, dial 611 and ask for Repair Service.

CALLS YOU CAN DIAL YOURSELF

FROM PAY TELEPHONES

You can dial direct all San Francisco numbers and the other numbers shown on the card at the telephone.

FROM OTHER TELEPHONES

You can dial direct most numbers that have 2 capitalized letters and a numeral in the prefix and four other numerals (like your own) in the San Francisco Bay area, and in a coastal strip extending from Eureka to San Luis Obispo.

If you have any questions, dial 211, your Long Distance operator.

After You Dial

An operator may come on the line and ask for the number of the telephone you are using. This is necessary to complete your call.

If You Reach a Wrong Number

The operator can adjust the charge. Ask whoever answers what city he is in. Then dial Operator immediately and tell her.

CALLS YOU PLACE THROUGH OPERATOR

There are certain calls you place through an operator:

Station-to-Station calls you cannot dial direct

Person-to-Person calls

Collect calls

Station-to-Station Calls

When you will talk with anyone who answers the called telephone, you make the call "station-to-station". Calls you dial yourself are station-to-station calls. To make a station-to-station call to a telephone you cannot dial yourself do this:

Dial 211 (Long Distance). From pay phones dial "O" or 211 as instructed on the telephone.

Tell the Operator the name of the city and the telephone number you want. If you do not know the number, give her the name and address the telephone is listed under and tell her you will talk with anyone who answers.

Person-to-Person Calls

When you want to talk to a particular person, department or PBX extension, you can make the call "person-to-person".

To do so, dial 211.

Tell the Operator the name of the city . . . the telephone number (or the name and address of the telephone) . . . and what person, department or extension you want.

The charge for this kind of call is somewhat more than for a "station-to-station" call.

Collect Calls

When you want your call billed to the number you are calling, you can make the call "collect".

To do so, dial 211.

Tell the Operator when you place the call—not afterwards—that you want it made "collect".

The minimum charge for a "collect" call is 30c. Otherwise, collect calls cost the same as other calls.

Other Long Distance Calls

It will help also if you ask for:

Upon request, the Operator will notify you at the end of a stated period of time on long distance calls.

For Long Distance Rates to Other Points See Inside Front and Back Cover.

The map on page 4 shows your message unit calling area. Message unit rates are shown below. The rate for each message unit is 4.25c, Federal Tax not included. On calls from pay phones, hotel private branch exchange and business foreign exchange services the rate for each message unit is 5c.

If an itemized bill is desired on any call made outside of your local calling area, but within the message unit calling area, such call should be placed with the operator by dialing "O" and asking her to place the call as a station tall call. The charge for such a call will be at regular long distance rates, which are generally higher than message unit rates.
