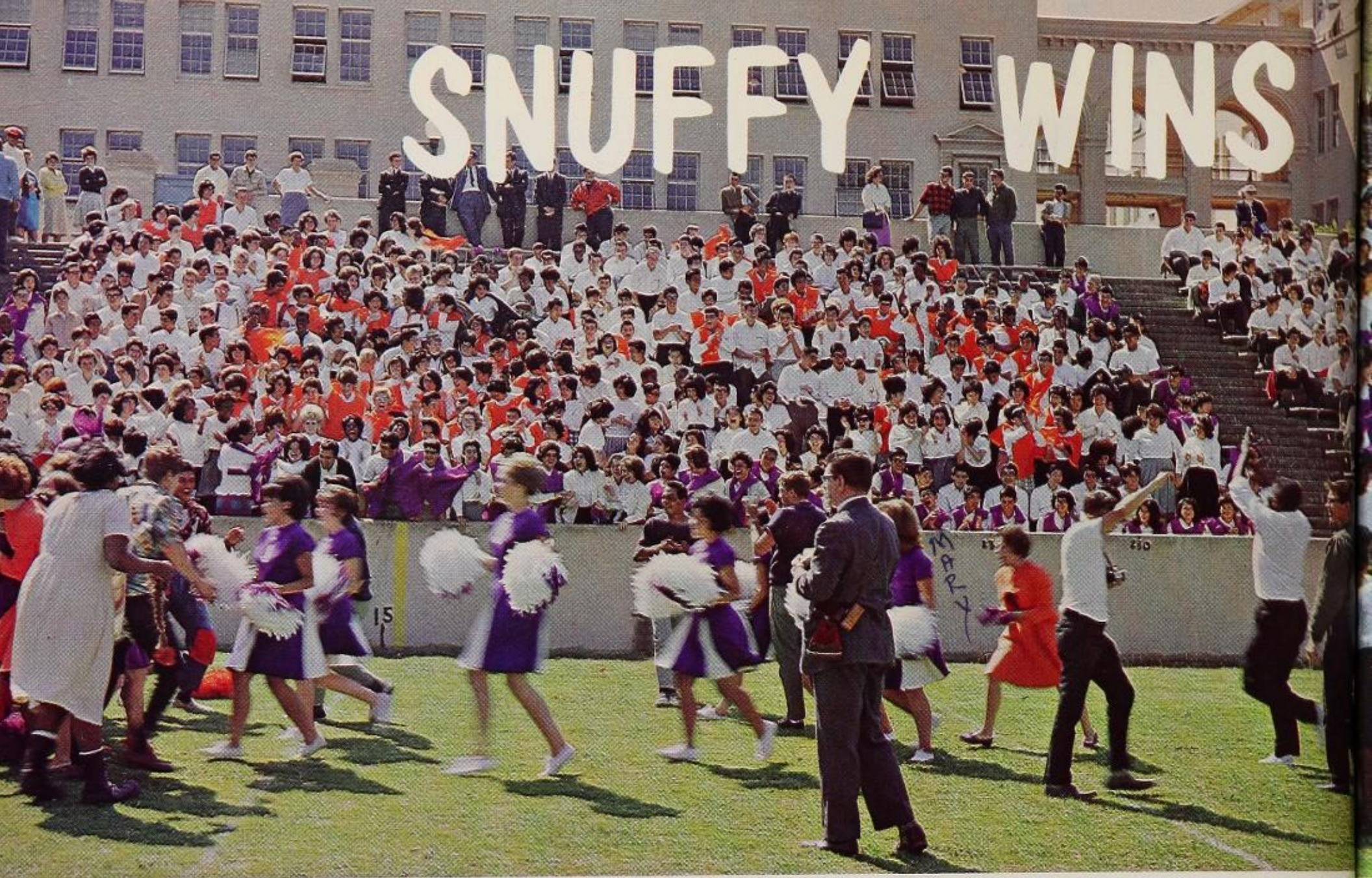


## **Lynn Pecuilionis**

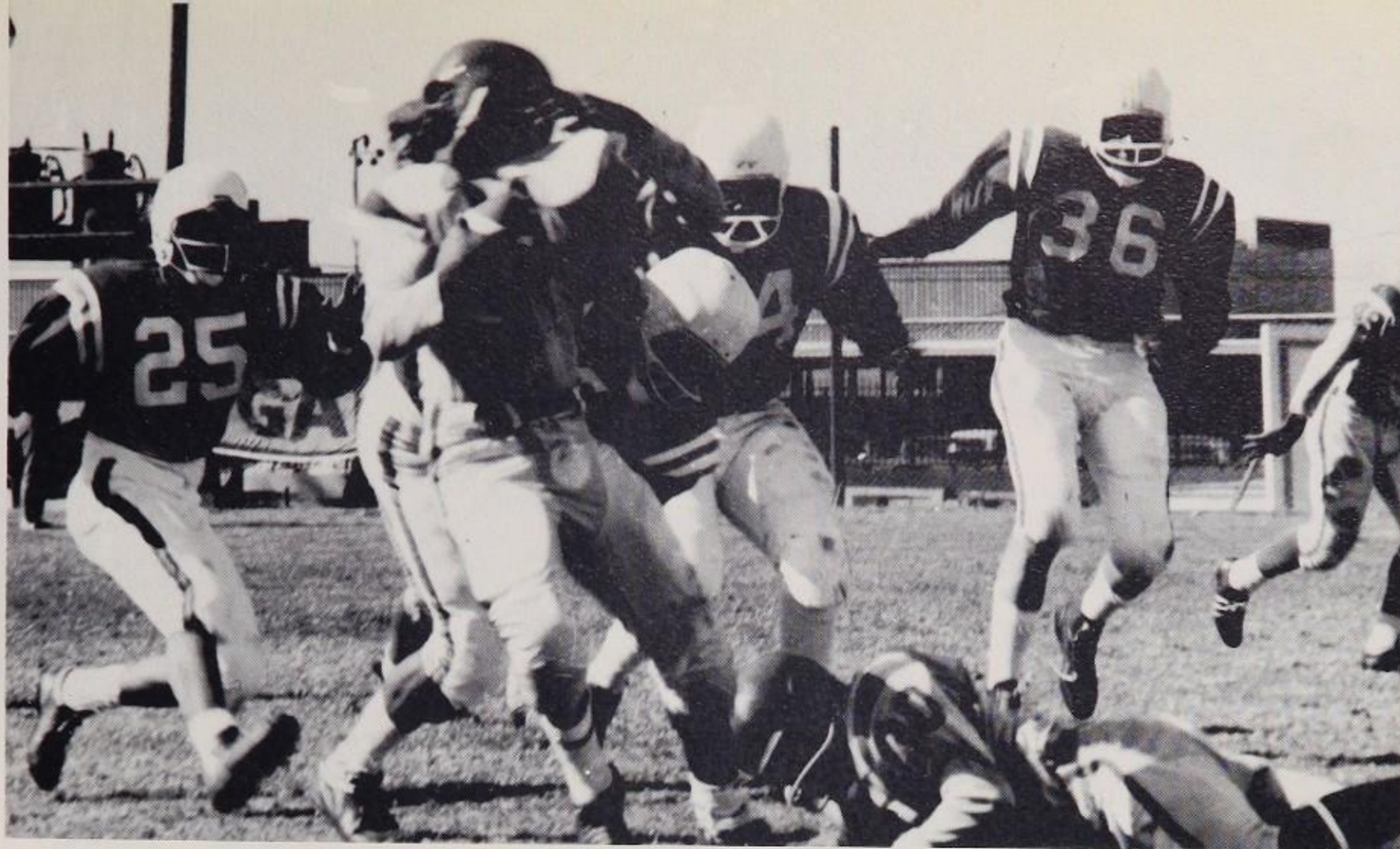

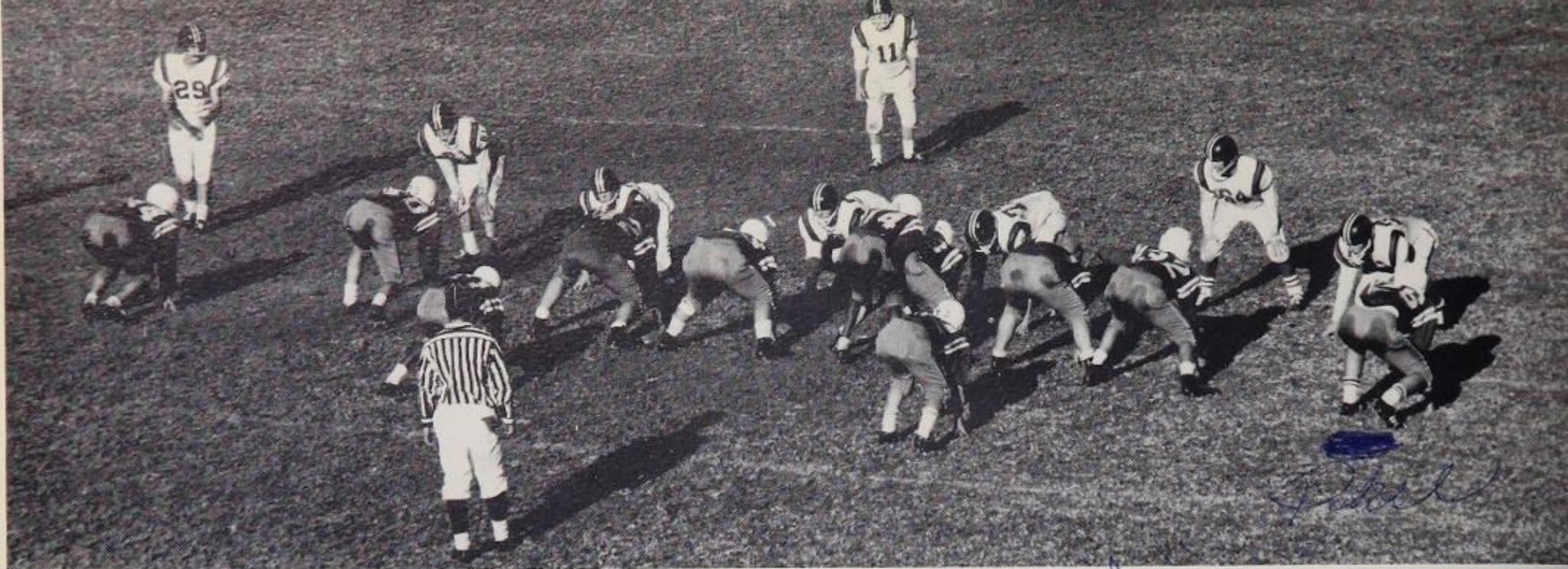

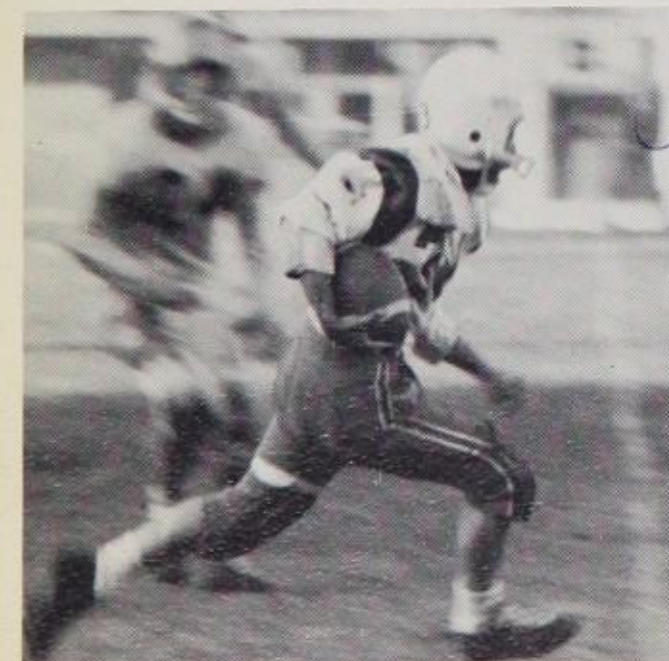
## J. V.'S 2nd

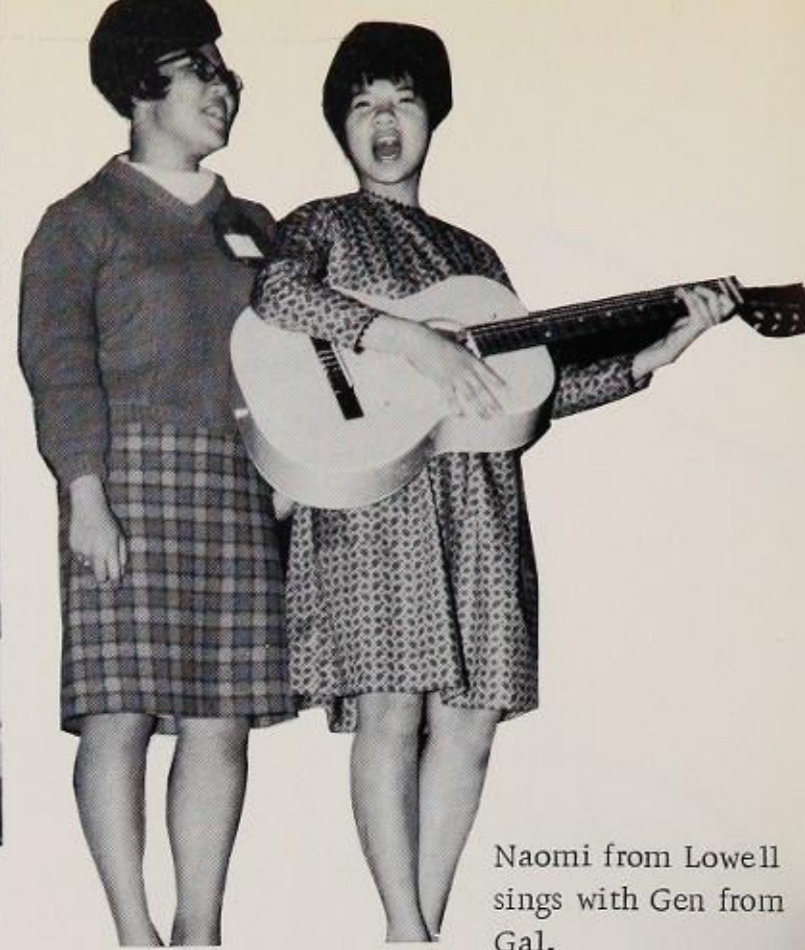

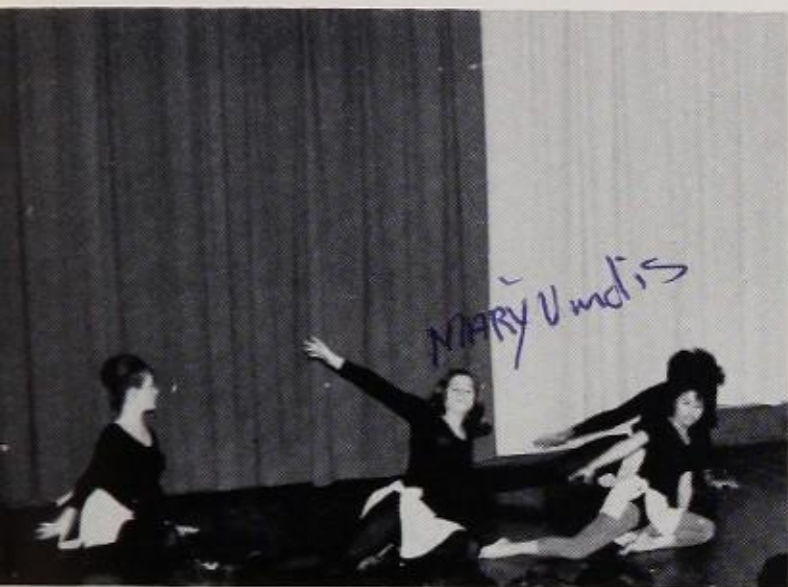
## AWARDS ASSEMBLY

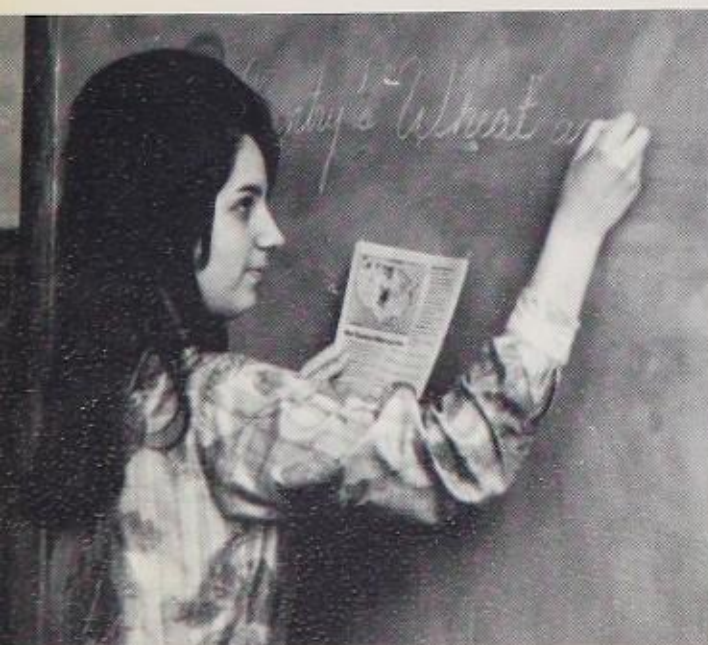

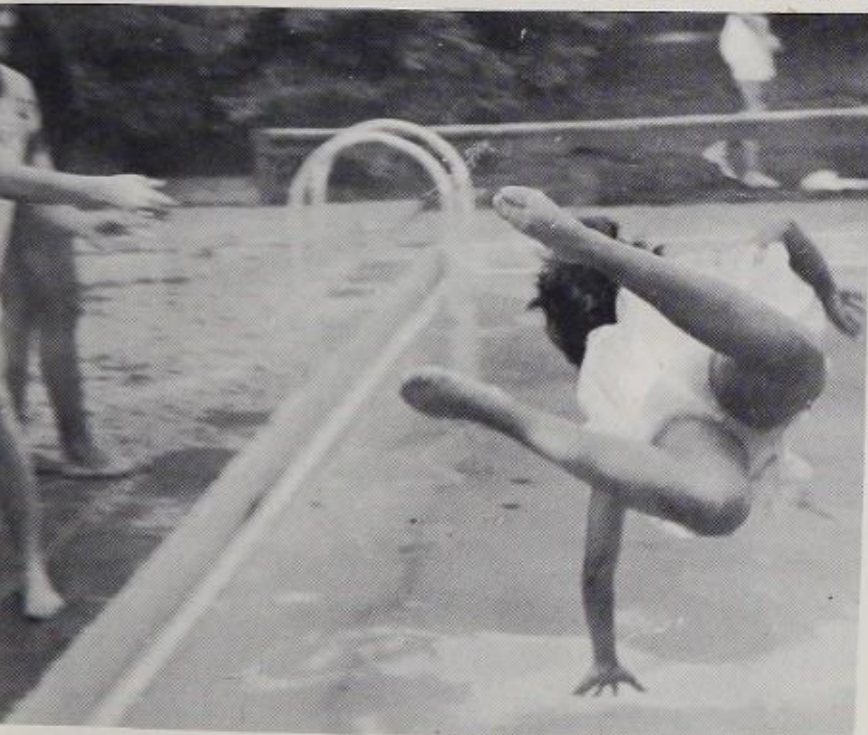






# Senior Picnic

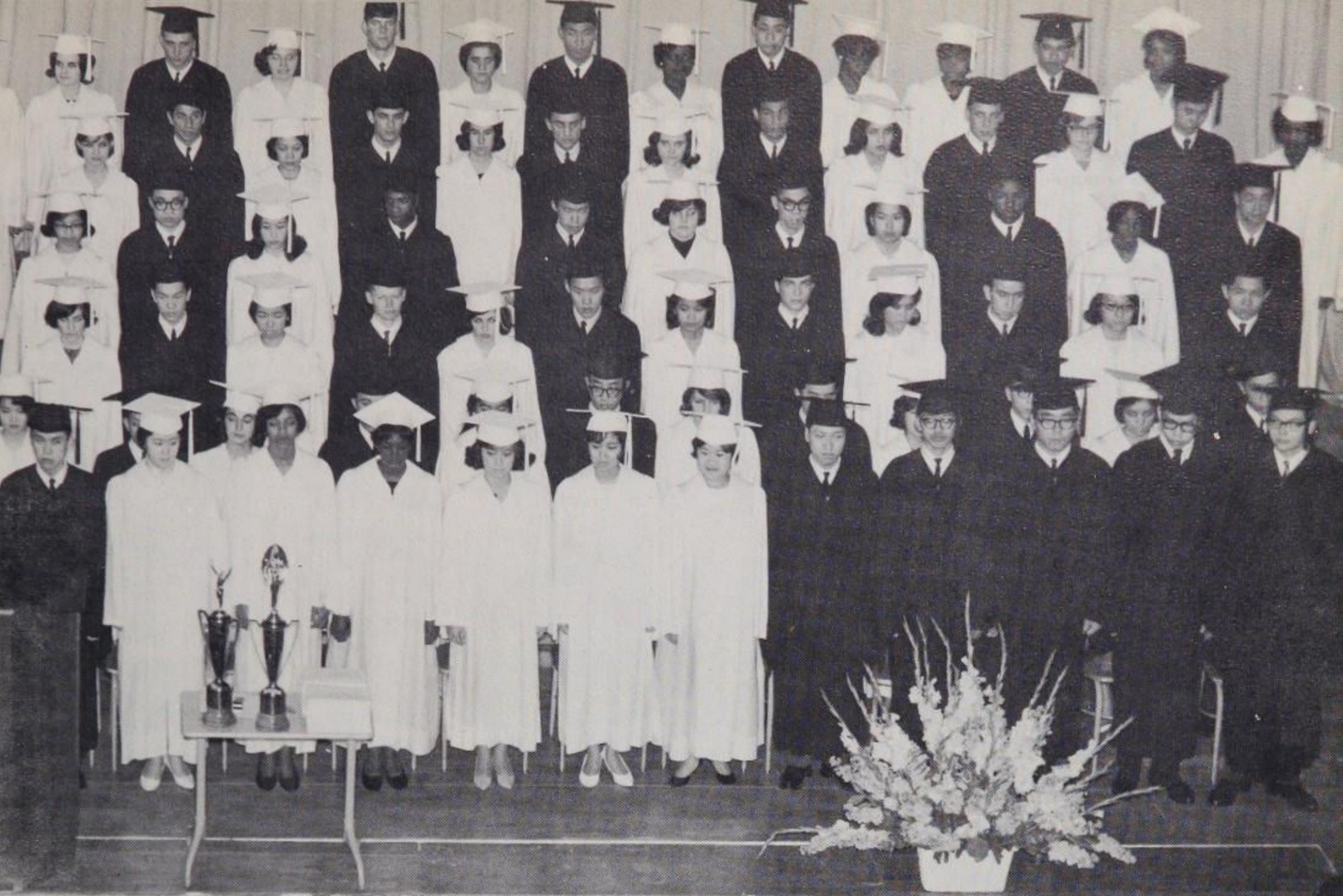




Oh, Galileo, "To thee we raise our voices." As members of Galileo's Fall Class of 1963, we shall never forget our three years here.

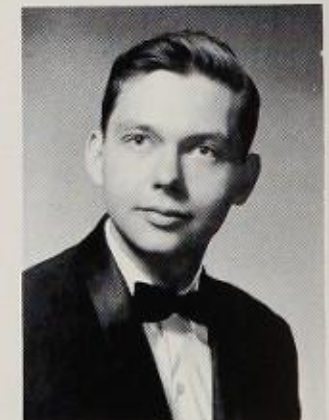

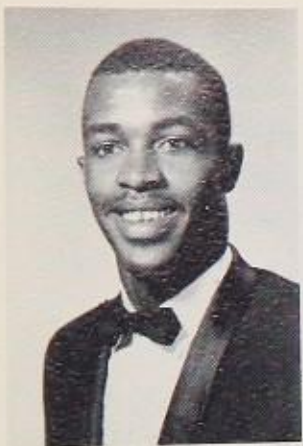


## LEANNA LARSON

# R. O. T. C.

The National Defence Act of 1916 established ROTC programs in high school's throughout the United States.

In 1919 Joseph P. Nourse is credited with the organization of Junior ROTC units in the San Francisco High Schools.

Joseph P. Nourse was Galileo High School's first principal when Jr. ROTC was first started in this school on August 1, 1921. At that time 153 Galileo students were receiving ROTC training. In 1964 our enrollment is up to 240 cadets, the highest enrollment in the Jr. ROTC program in the San Francisco High Schools.

The Jr. ROTC program is intended to train boys for leadership and responsible citizenship. These are two of the most important qualities which one should achieve in school. ROTC gives cadets the satisfaction that occurs from team sports. It regards individual excellence in both academic and mechanical proficiency, such as becoming an expert rifleman or a member of the drill team. There are many programs at Galileo which offer students opportunities to practice leadership. ROTC extends these opportunities. There have been many cadets in ROTC who have been tops in sports and school service while at the same served as ROTC leaders.

ROTC has performed a great service to the school in many ways. Cadets are ushers at all commencement exercises of graduating Galileo students. The Galileo ROTC Battalion has been reviewed in Parades and Ceremonies by many top-ranking military and civic officials. Jr. ROTC has had a long record of service to Galileo since the schools opening 43 years ago.

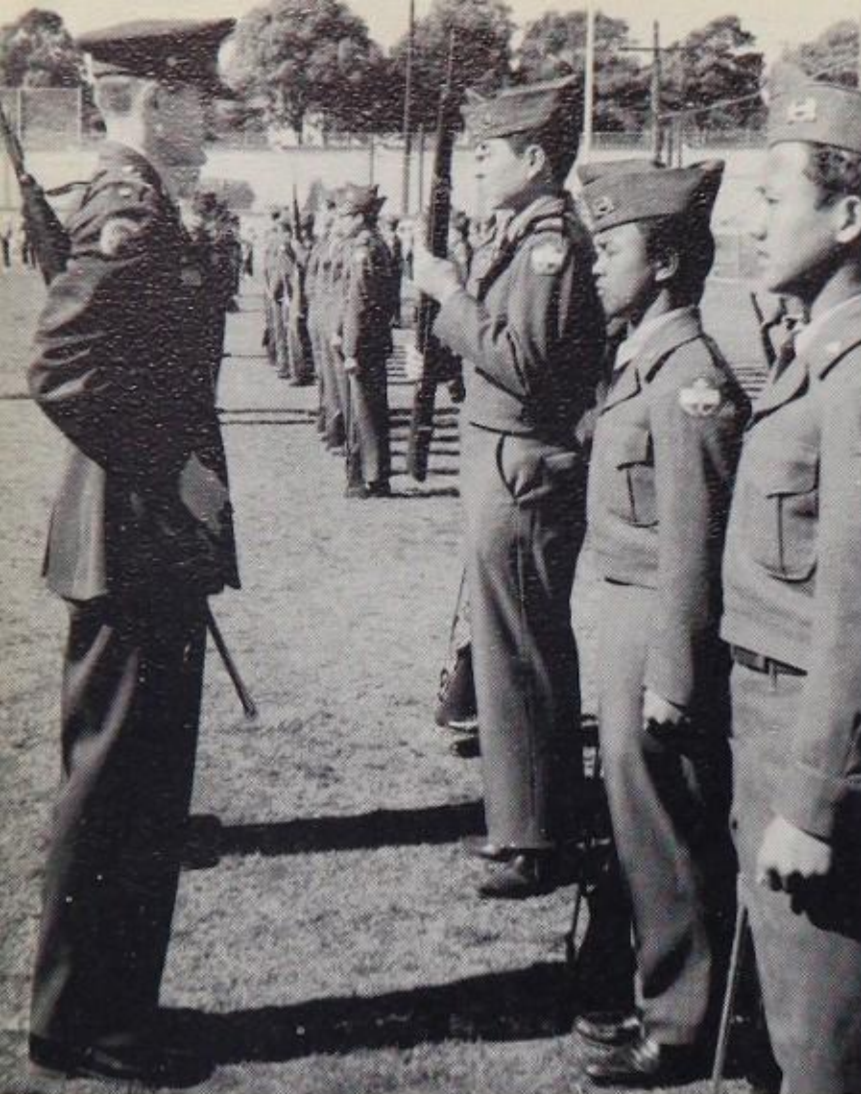

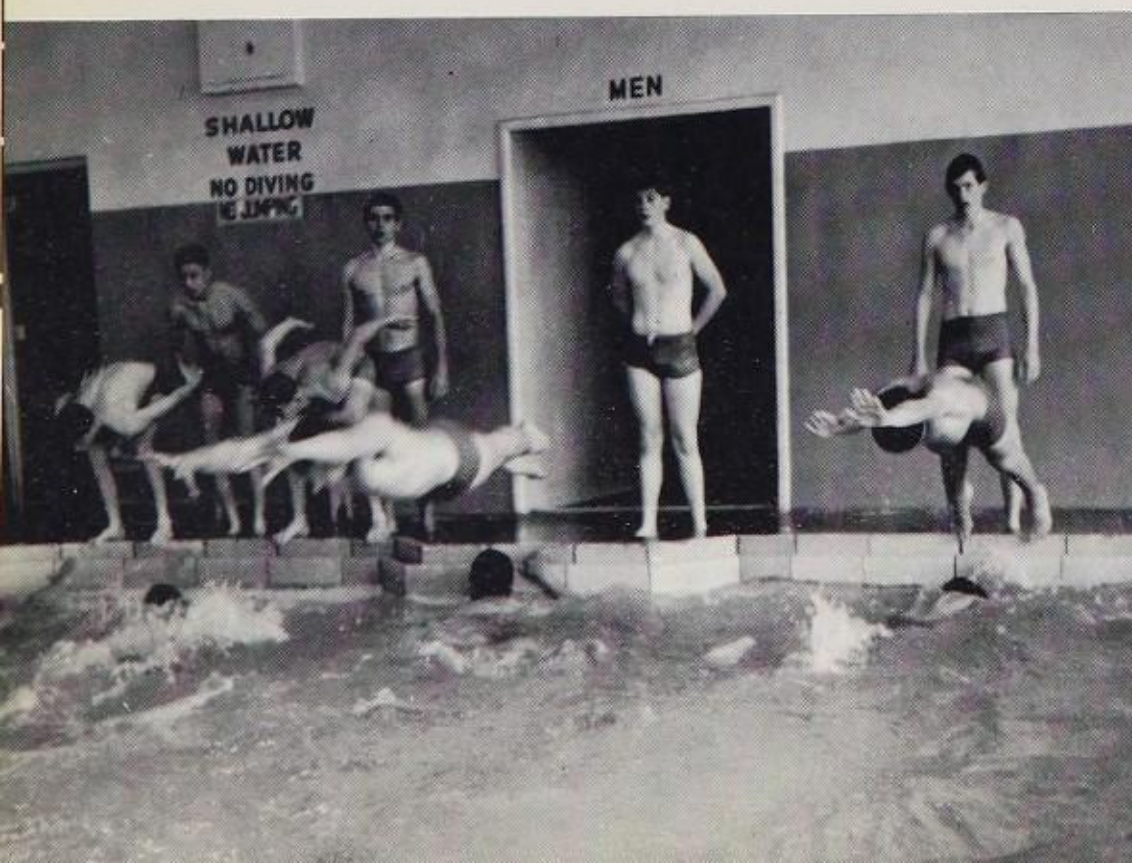

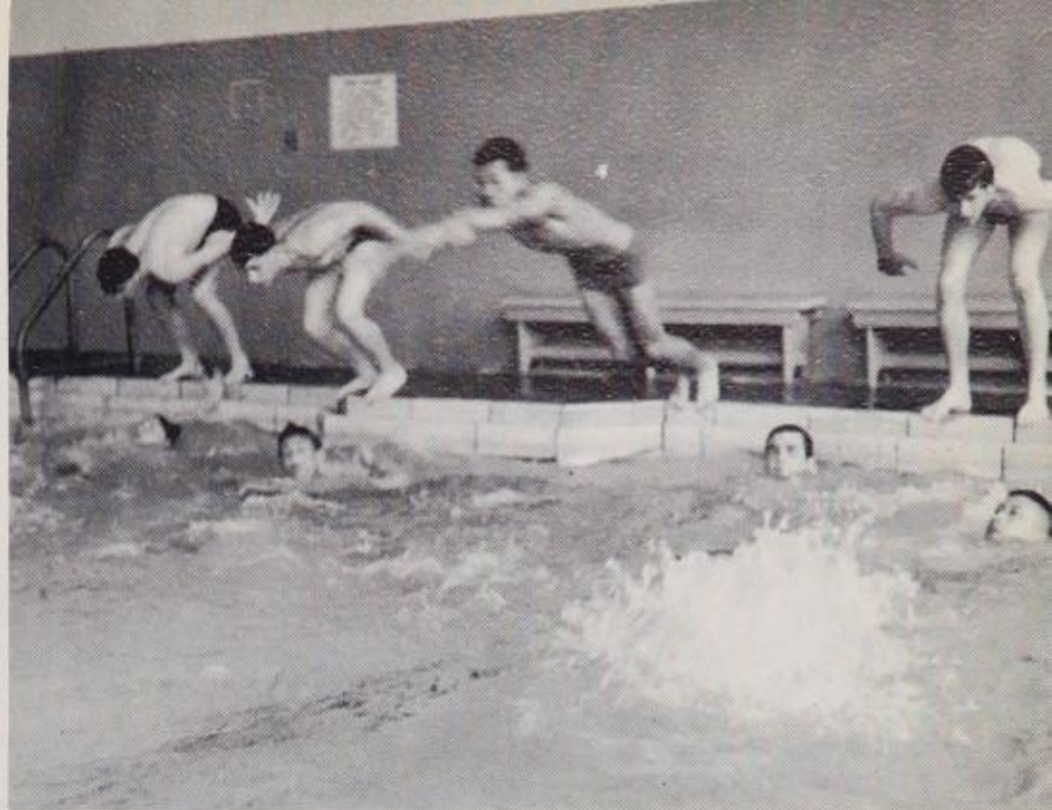

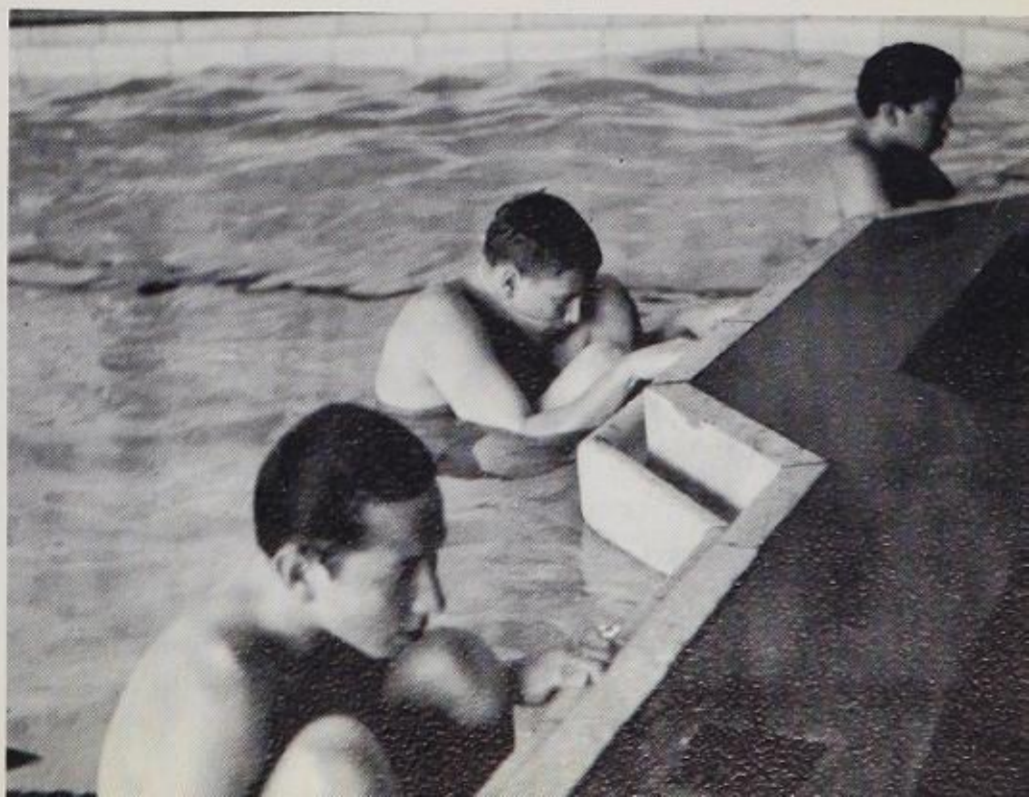

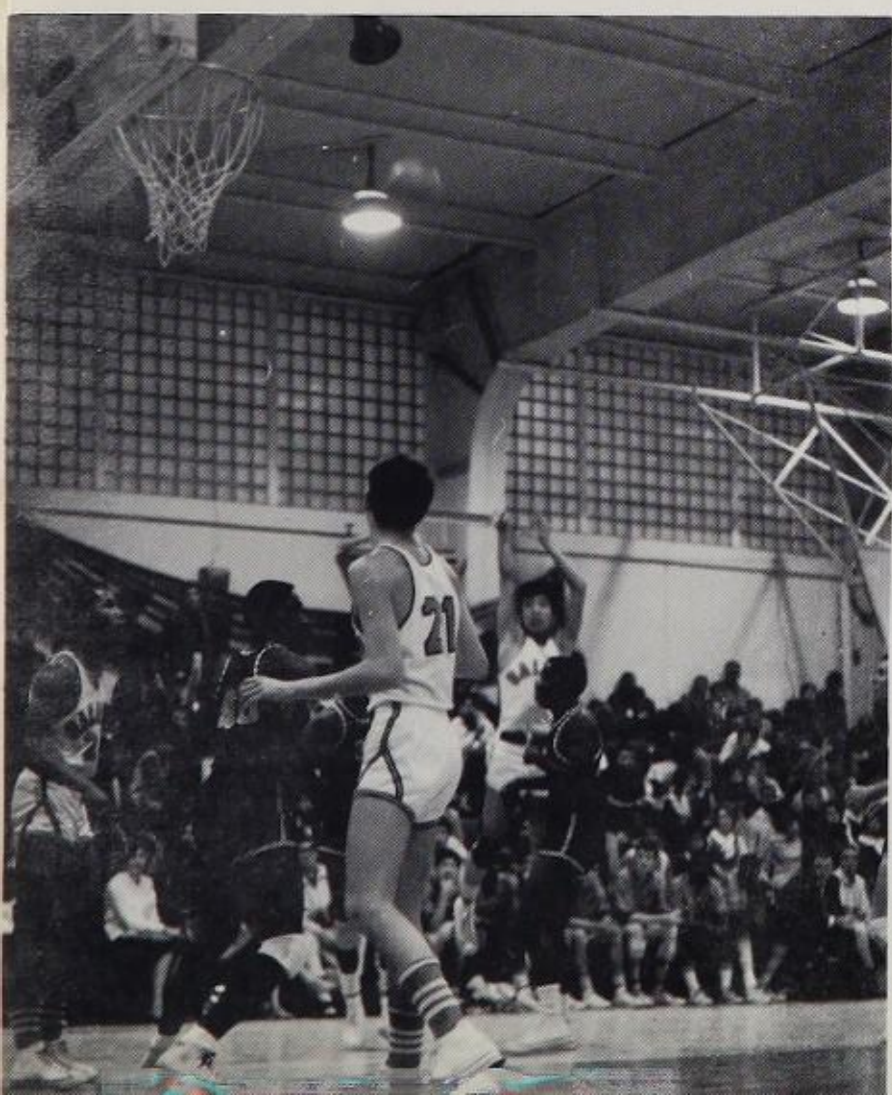

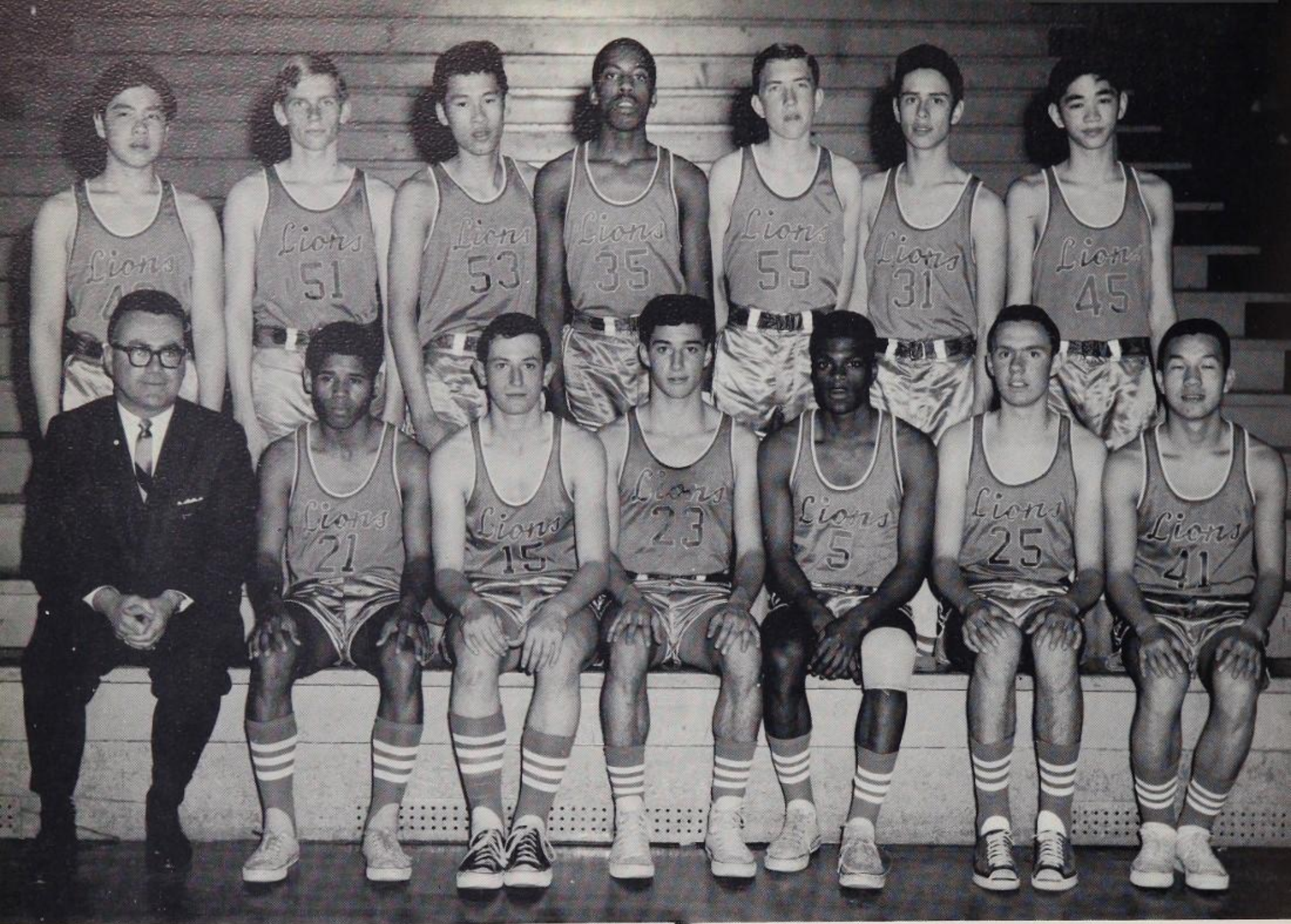

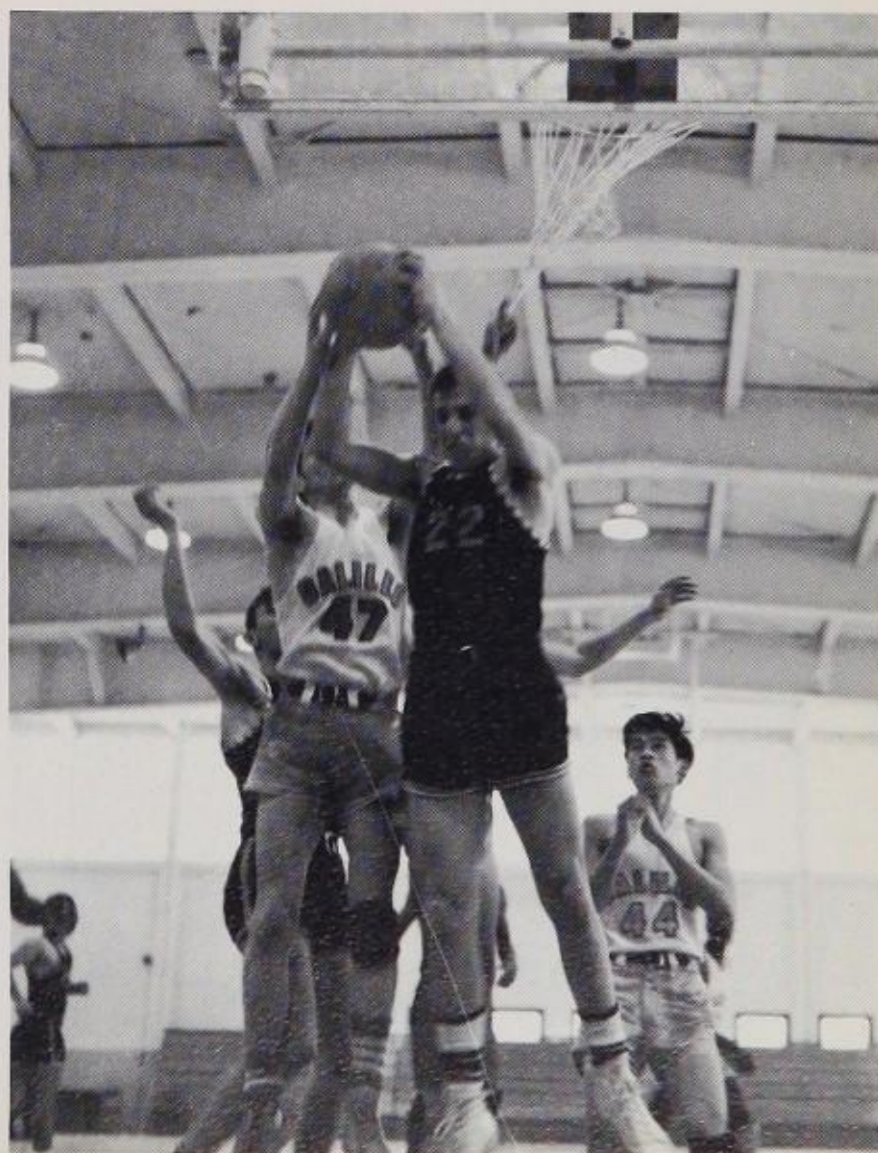

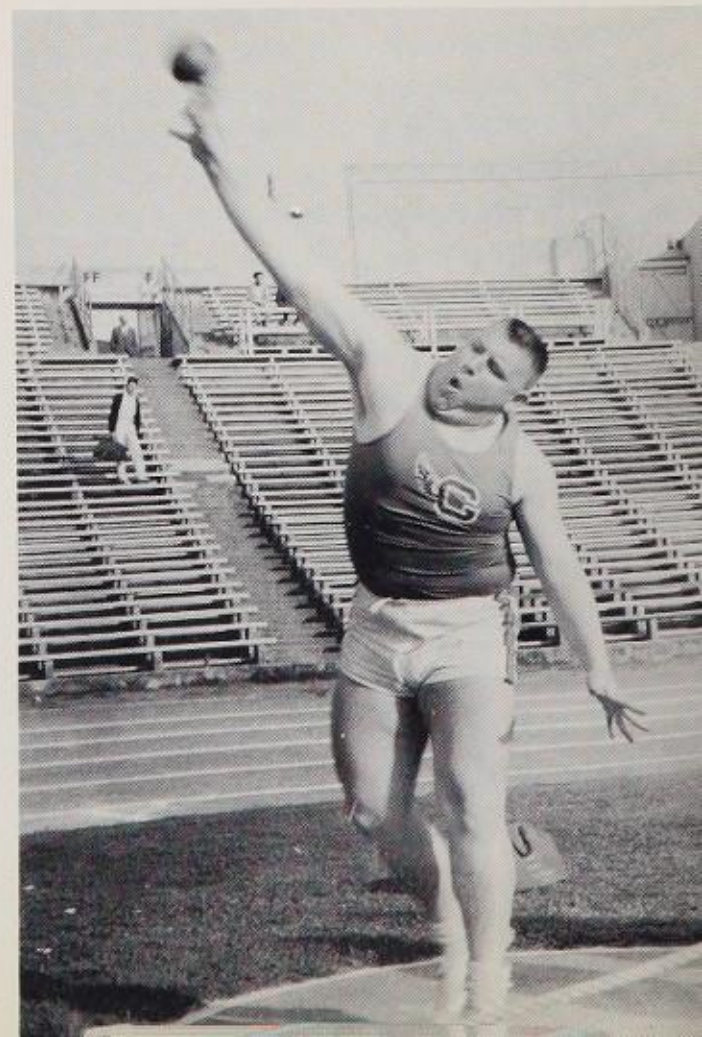

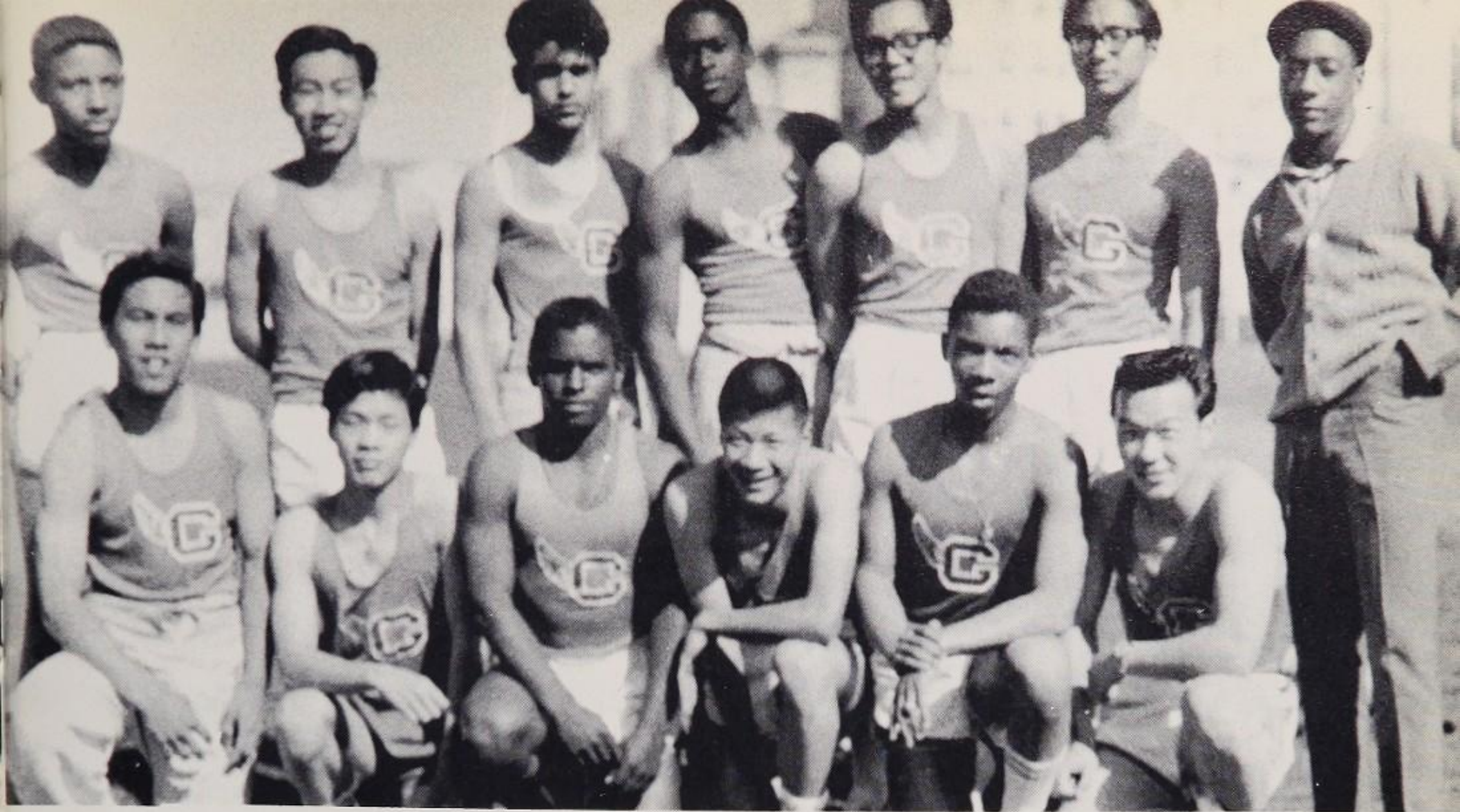

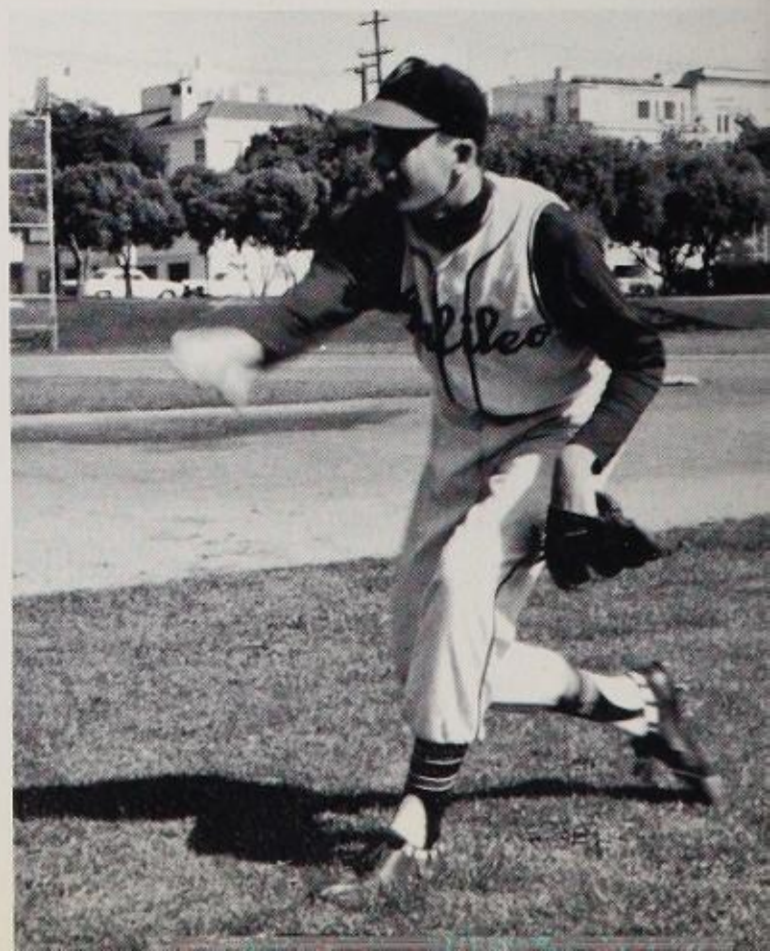

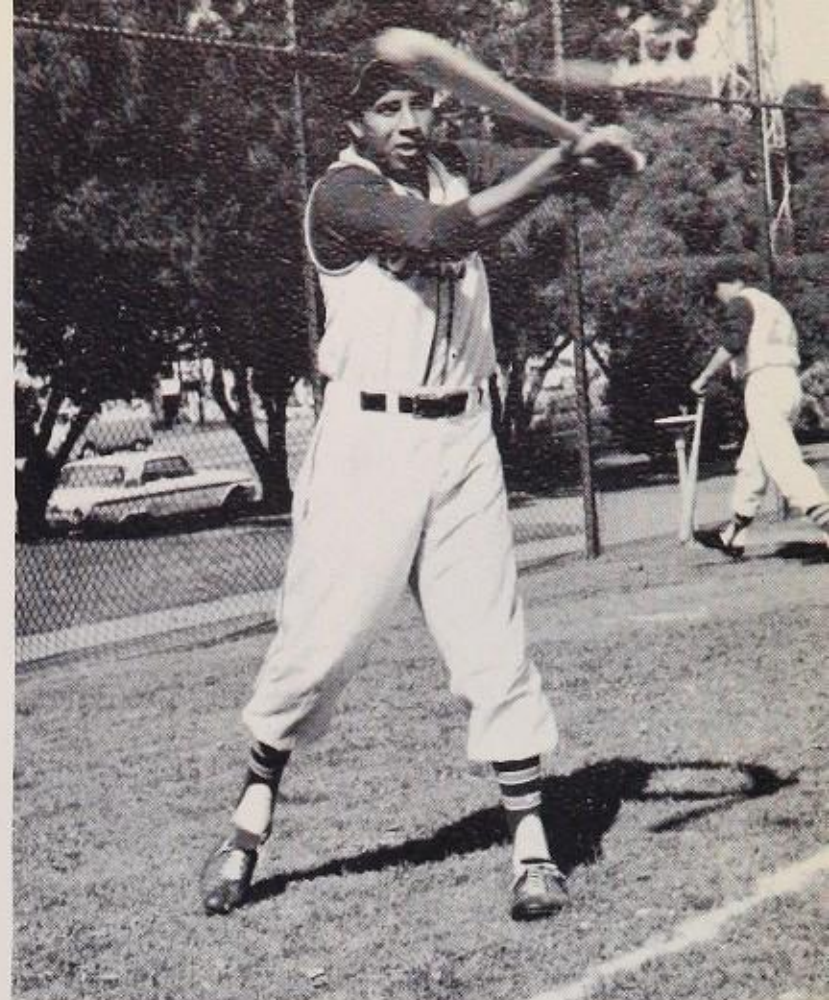

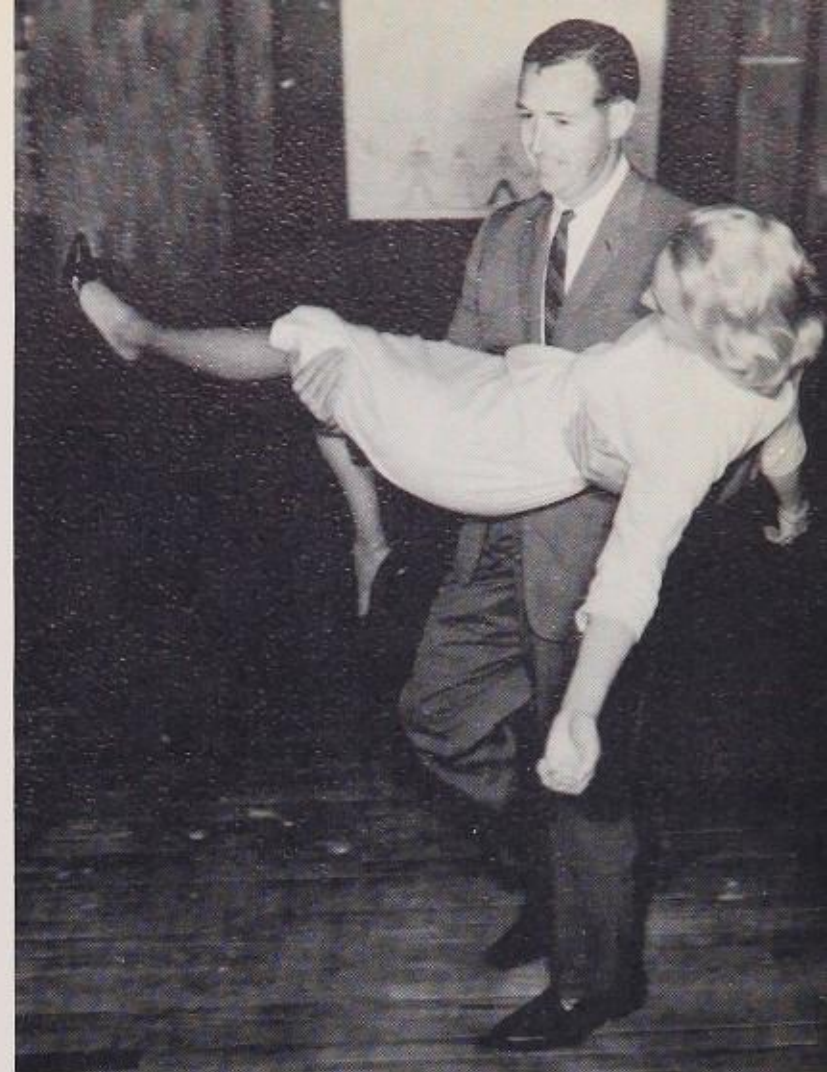
