

This year, the Varsity Basketball team of Washington High placed an overall third place in the AAA league with a 11-5 record.

The Varsity Head Coach, John McGrath, has 18 years of coaching experience behind him. During his coaching career at Washington, McGrath has led his teams to 14 play-off berths and one AAA All-City Championship and is a graduate of Humboldt State College. Coach McGrath also gets help from the Assistant Coach, Tom Swartz, who keeps the scorebook for the varsity.

Tracy Haynes was on the All-City J.V.'s as a center and was one of the players who led his team to the Championship game of 1973. He then joined the varsity this year, played the center position again, and is one of the Eagles outstanding rebounders. Tracy also was voted for "Honorable Mention" by the S.F. Examiner.

Fred Reid in his sophomore year played for the 115's City Championship team in which he was named one of the AII- City guards in the AAA and again in the J.V.'s. This year in the varsity, he played the position of guard again and along with Tracy Haynes, he was also voted for "Honorable Mention" by the S.F. Examiner.

Led by Ken Herrera, the Junior Varsity squad won a respectible third place in All-City meet, culminating a very successful 6-1 season.


