## Varsity Football










Serramonte's Frosh Football team posted a most impressive 5 win, 2 loss season in establishing the Regents as a football powerhouse in the NPL. It was by far the best Freshman record in the schools history, and indicates that the young football players in the area are finding success at this school.

The year started impressively with scrimmage victories over an extremely fine Westborough team, and a stunning defeat of the Lowell JV squad. Then the Frosh posted their first two league victories over powerhouse Terra Nova and Oceana. The Parkway contest was the Regents poorest showing, but even in losing 28–14 Serramonte showed that it was a team that could come back. Then eventual league champion Half Moon Bay took the measure of the Regents in a very hard fought 8–0 ball game. Finally the Frosh closed the year with successive wins over Alta Loma, Southwood, and Jefferson.

"This was a fun year, of course winning is always fun, but the players were a fantastic group to work with. They showed a great deal of courage, and determination throughout the year. The success they have enjoyed is a tribute to their ability and willingness to work hard. They should provide the nucleus of a fine Varsity in a couple of years." - Coach Doctolero.

Outstanding players for this year's Freshman were Cheyenne Tuufuli, who averaged over 100 yards per game on the ground. Lou Tinsley, Bob Cuellar and Al Huges. Russ Pinomaki, Fred Miranda, and James Broussard were excellent linemen along with Maverick Tuufuli. Nick DeGuzman, Cuellar and Huges were team leaders on defense averaging 9 tackles each.






#### VARSITY


## Serramonte Sprockets Bicycle Club
